Part C: Reading Comprehension

Grahame is one of the most famous children's stories of the 20th century and one of the best-known ever written in English. It has been made into a play, Toad of Toad Hall, by A.A. Milne, and into a film, Mr. Toad, by Walt Disney.

Kenneth Grahame was born in Edinburgh, Scotland. When he was only three years old, his mother died, and he went to England with his brothers and sister to live with his grandmother. He missed his mother very much, and to calm himself, he began to daydream and to make up stories. When he was ten, he was sent to school in Oxford, coming back for holidays to his new home near the River Thames. He was very disappointed when his father refused to let him enter Oxford University and sent him to work in the Bank of England instead.

Grahame worked hard at banking, and he rose to the important post of secretary of the bank. It was not the sort of life he really wanted. In his spare time, he wrote The Golden Age, published in 1895, a book of stories telling of the games and heroic adventures. Neither this book nor Dream Days, which followed three years later, was written for children, for in both of them the author was looking back at childhood from an adult's point of view. However, Dream Days contains one entertaining story which children enjoy reading.
