

Collecting money

Remember

There are 100 **cents** in every **dollar**.

You will need: a collection of 10-cent, 50-cent and dollar coins or notes, a 1–6 dice, a tray or dish to use as a bank

Vocabulary

cent, dollar, money, coins, value

This is a game for two players.

Place all the money in the bank.

Each put your counter at the beginning of the track.

Take turns to roll the dice and move that number of spaces.

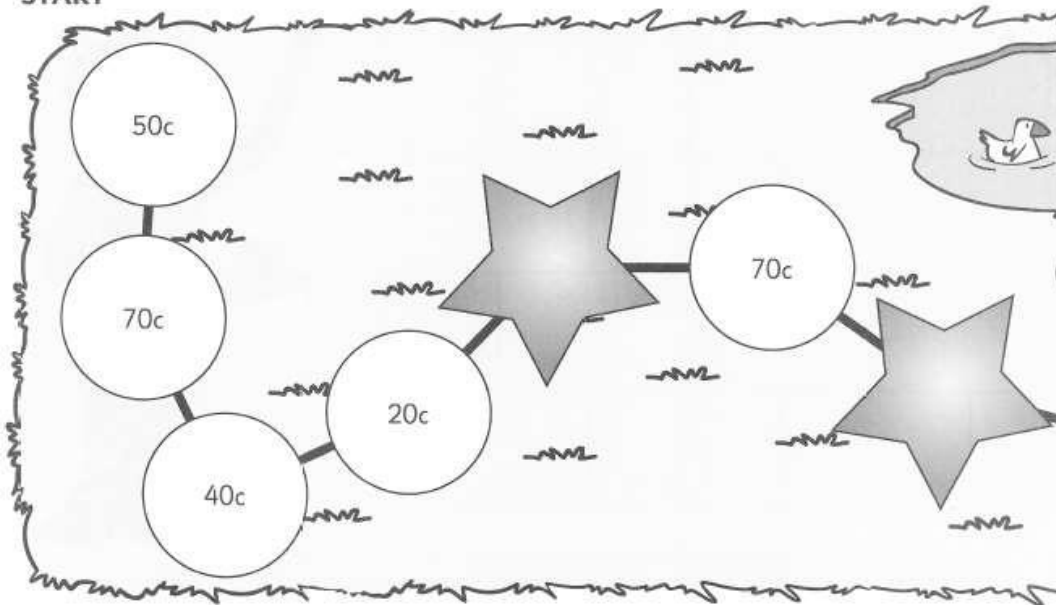
If you land on an amount of money, take that amount from the bank.

If you land on a star, take a dollar from the bank.

When you have collected 100 cents, exchange them for a dollar from the bank.

The winner is the player with more money at the end of the track.
