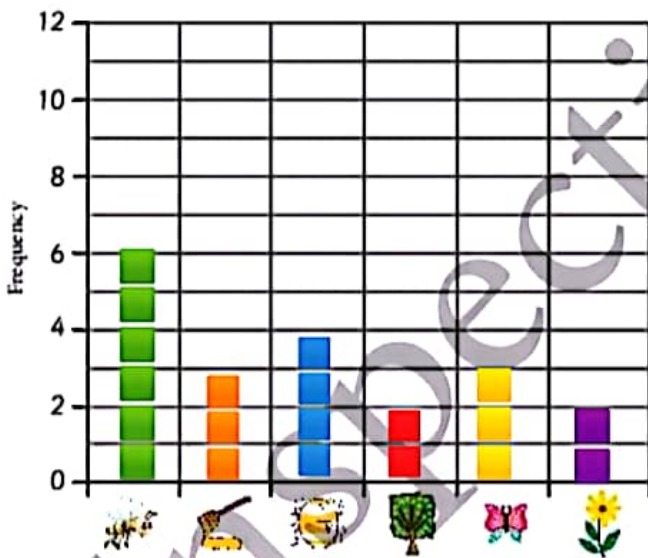

5.2. Honey, bees and butterflies

Remember

A bar chart shows data as bars of different heights. Frequency is the number of times what you are counting occurs.
