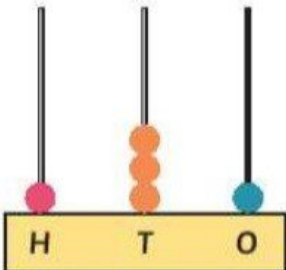
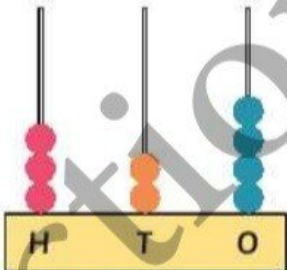
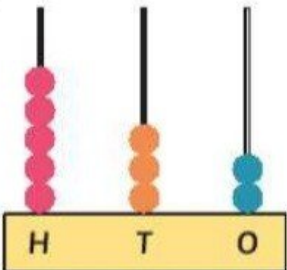
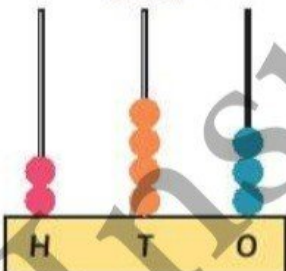
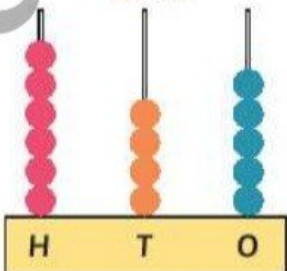
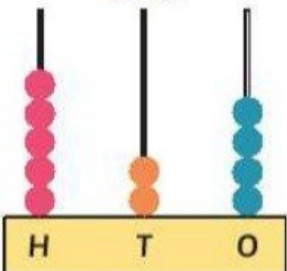
Hundreds, tens and ones
