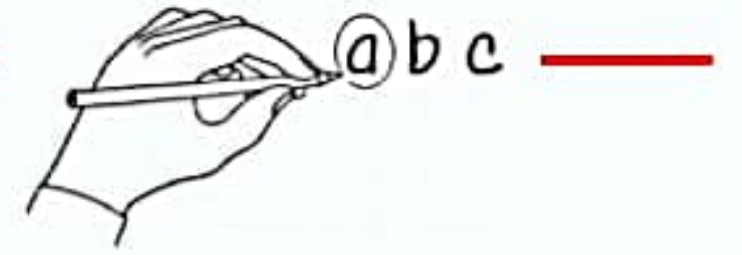


We can use the past simple of the verb *to be* to talk about situations and states in the past.

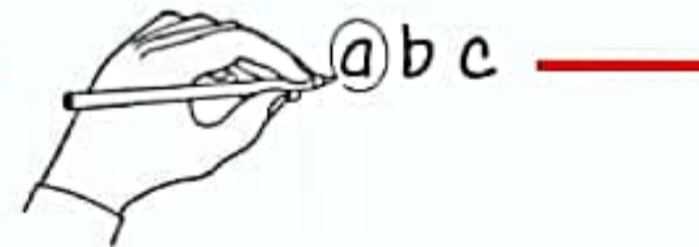
