**If she comes to my party, I will be very happy.**

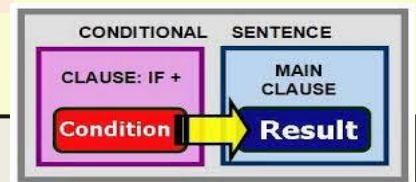
