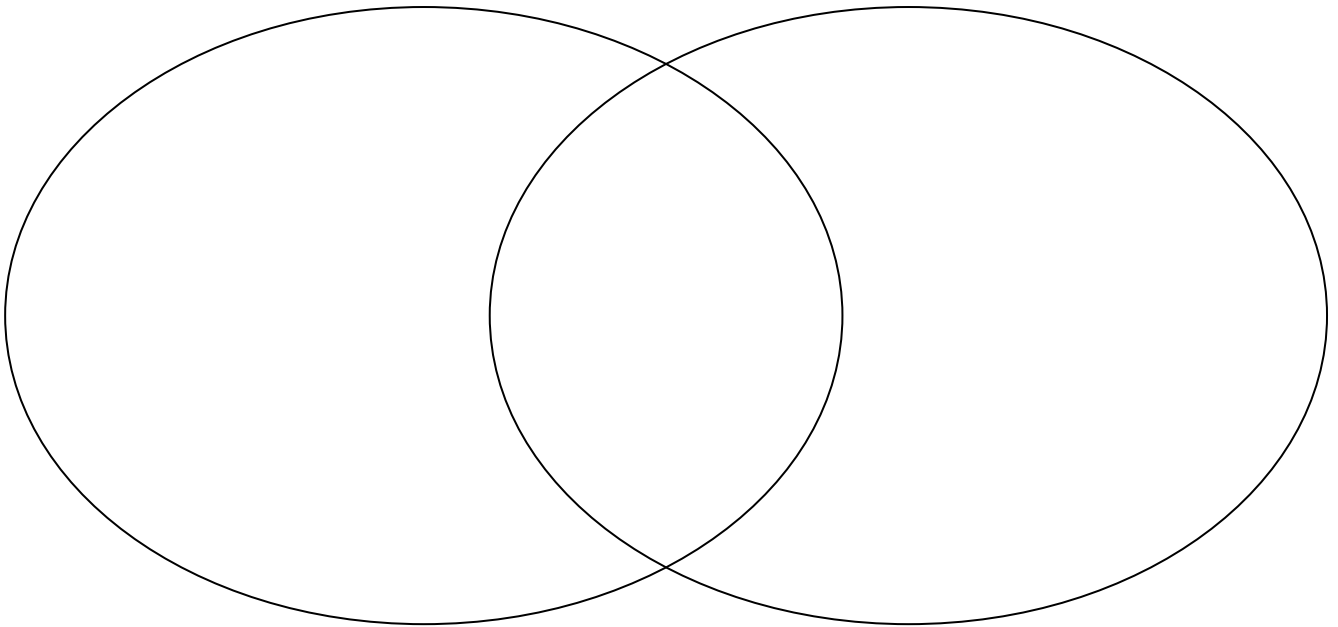

A1. What are the steps involved in making music? (at least 3 steps)

First, write a song and rehearse.

Then, the musicians rehearse the songs.

Finally, they record their songs on CD's using computers.

A2. What is touring and why do some people like it?

Touring is a short visit to many places.

Some people like touring because they can visit new places and meet people who teach new them things. Also, they can see entertainers perform. They can go to a baseball game in a stadium or an orchestra.

A3. Why do some people not like touring?

Some people do not like touring because they sometimes feel lonely, because all their friends and family are at home.

A4. Where do musicians play their music? (2 places)

Musicians play in stadiums, studios, and arenas. (/10)

An actor is a person who plays different kinds of characters on TV, in a movie, or on a stage.

You can see an actor perform on TV, stage, in plays, movies, or at studios.

Actors act by pretending and showing emotions. They have to memorize their lines using scripts.

Actor use lights, special effects, and microphones.

TV or movies are recorded, so they can try again. Stage actors perform live , in front of an audience, and cannot try again if they make a mistake.
