Is this your scarf? Yes, it's **mine**. (**not** <del>Yes, it's my scarf</del>.) Are these your trainers? Yes, they're **ours**. (**not** <del>Yes, they're our</del> <del>trainers</del>.)

• Mine is always singular.

Who do these trainers belong to? They're mine. (not mines)

There is no pronoun form for its.
