How to Use Present Simple

The Present Simple is used to talk about habits, facts, and things that happen regularly. It helps talk about things that are always true or will always be true. It is also used to talk about things that happen in the present, such as our daily routines.

Examples

- **I work in an office.** Routine fact
- **He lives in London.** Present/ habit
- **She drives to work every day.** Habit/ daily routine
- **We have dinner at 7 pm.** Habit/ daily routine
- **They watch TV every night.** Habit/ daily routine

The Structure of the Present Simple Tense

Affirmative sentences:

Subject + infinitive

Negative sentences:

Subject + do/does + not + infinitive

Interrogative sentences:

Do/Does + subject + infinitive

Negative interrogative sentences:

Do/Does + subject + not + infinitive

Don't forget -s

She
he
it

Simple Present: *Simply add -s to he/she/it*

Singular	I	buy	read	think	come	eat
	you	buy	read	think	come	eat
	he she it	buys	reads	thinks	comes	eats
Plural	you we they	buy	read	think	come	eat
