Present continuous



Affirmative	Negative
<i>I am wearing boots</i>	<i>I am not wearing jeans</i>
<i>He/she is wearing boots</i>	<i>He/she is not wearing jeans</i>
<i>We/you/they are wearing boots</i>	<i>We/you/they are not wearing jeans</i>
Questions	Short answers
<i>Am I wearing shoes?</i>	<i>Yes, I am / No, I am not</i>
<i>Is he/she wearing shoes?</i>	<i>Yes, he/she is / No, he/she isn't</i>
<i>Are we/you/they wearing shoes?</i>	<i>Yes, we/you/they are / No, we/you/they are not</i>

Present tense in English

Simple Present Tense

used for general truths, habitual actions, and permanent situations.

subject + verb

Present Continuous Tense

helps describe actions that are currently happening or in progress.

subject + auxiliary verb "be" + Present Participle


With future time
clause we use
simple present

e.g: I'll come
home when I
finish work

Present
continuous :
always +
something
that annoys
you

For future arrangement
we use present
continuous

e.g: I am visiting the
doctor
