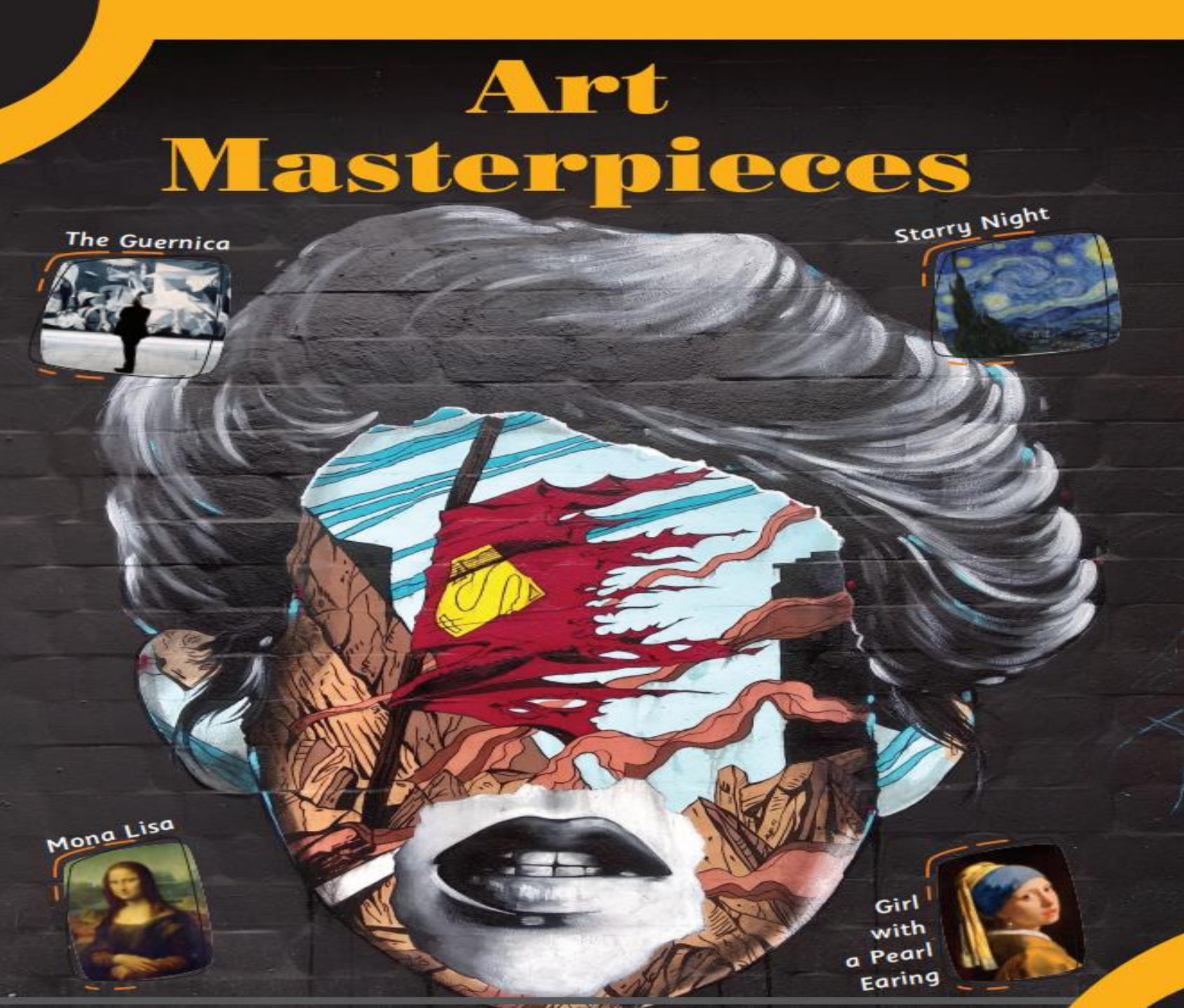

This painting is worth around \$782 million.



The Girl with a Pearl Earring depicts a young woman in a dark space. She wears a blue and gold turban, the pearl earring, and a gold jacket with a white collar. It was painted by Dutch artist Johannes Vermeer.

Some people believe that the girl in the painting is imaginary, whereas others believe that it is a real person. It is also said that she could be Vermeer's own daughter, Maria Vermeer.



Quick Facts:

-  Nobody knows exactly when the painting was completed. However, some people estimate that it was painted in the year 1665.
-  The original painting is quite small. It measures 44.5 by 39 centimeters.
-  Some people call this painting 'The Mona Lisa of the North' or 'The Dutch Mona Lisa'.
-  The work is kept in the Mauritshuis museum in the Netherlands.

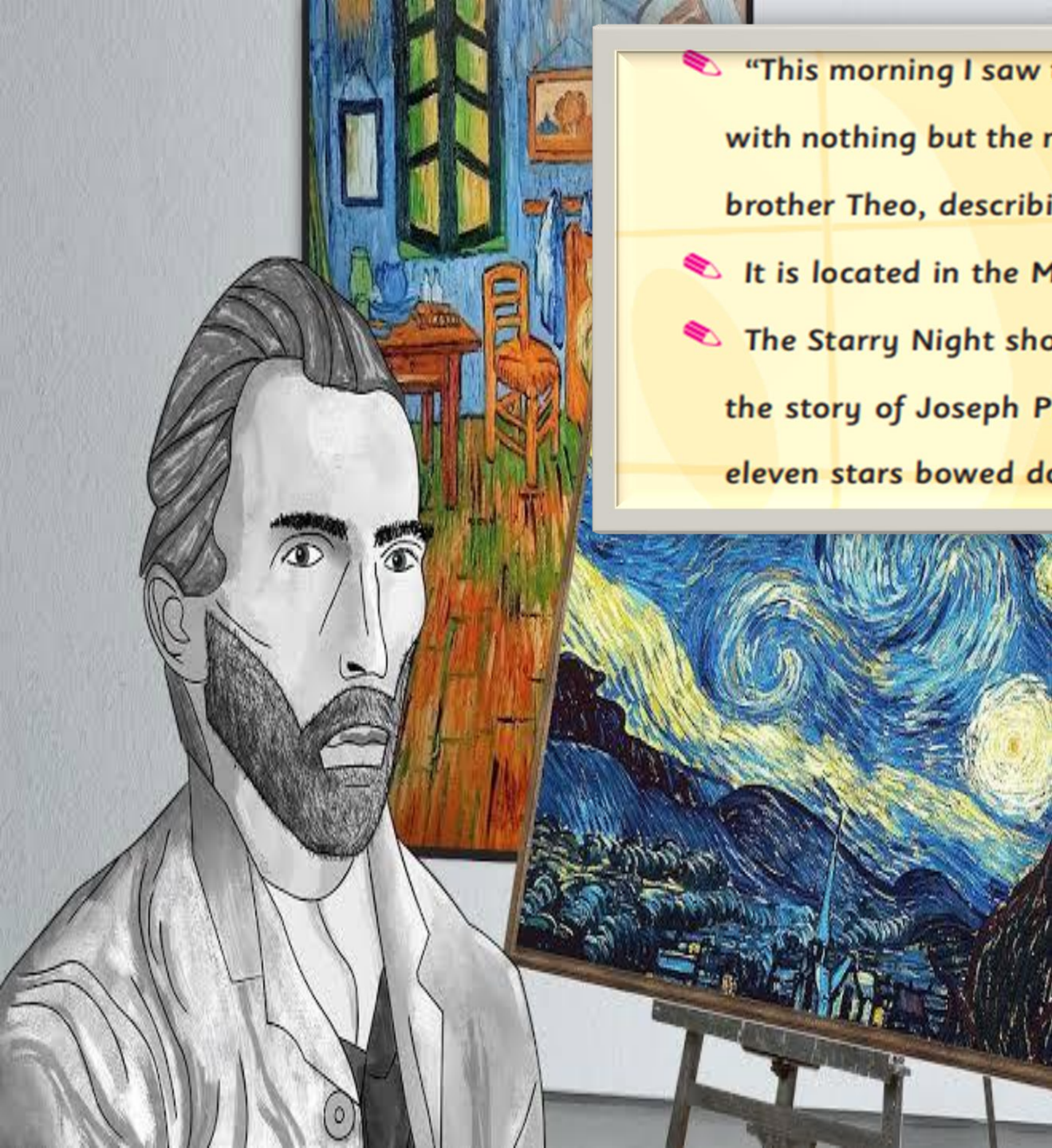

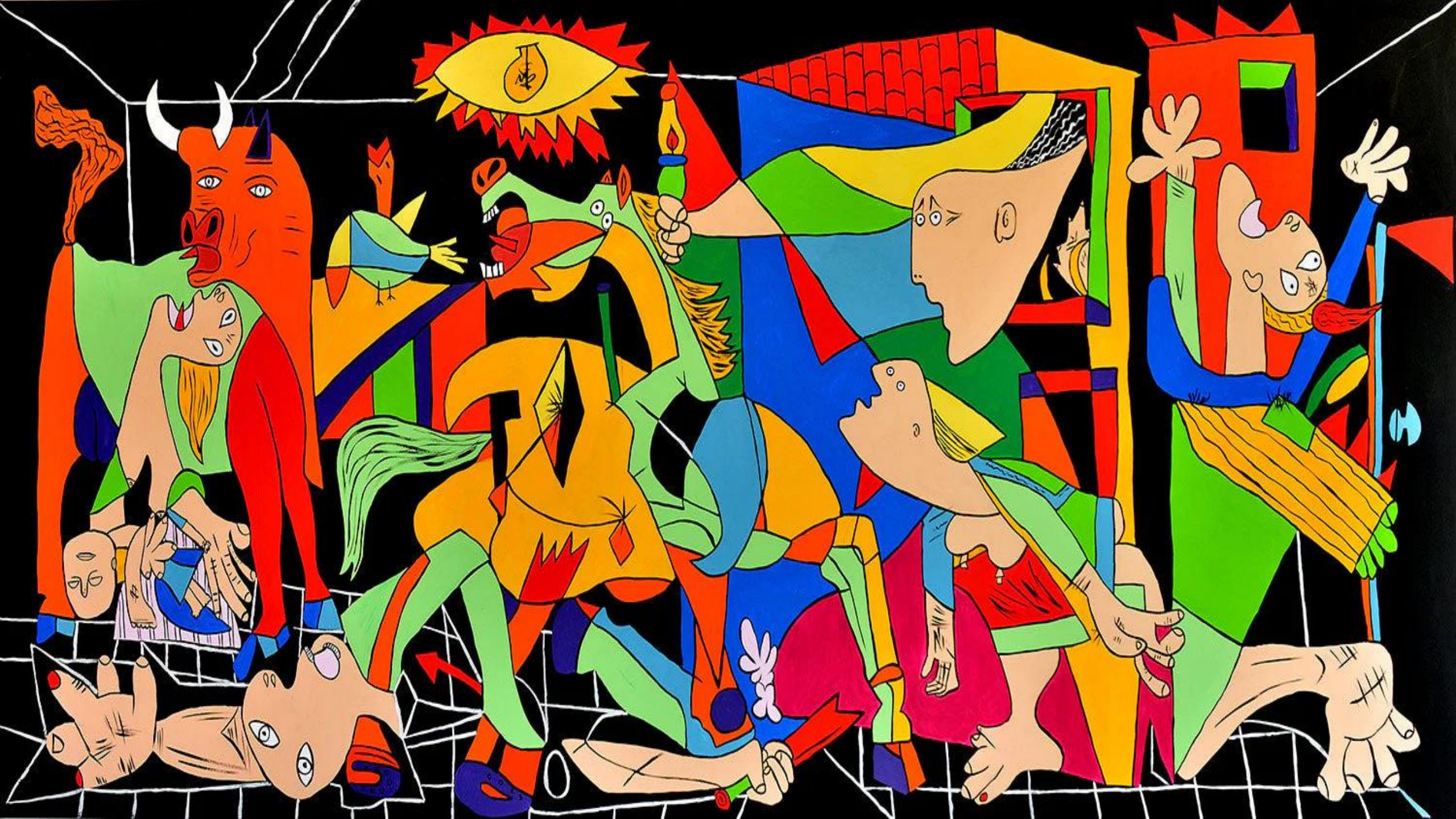
The Starry Night is a famous painting of a moonlit sky with stars in. It was painted by Vincent van Gogh in 1888 or 1889. Van Gogh spent one year in a mental hospital. This work shows the view from his room at the clinic.



- ✎ “This morning I saw the countryside from my window a long time before sunrise, with nothing but the morning star, which looked very big,” wrote van Gogh to his brother Theo, describing his inspiration for *The Starry Night*.
- ✎ It is located in the Museum of Modern Art in New York.
- ✎ *The Starry Night* shows exactly 11 stars. Many people believe that they refer to the story of Joseph Prophet who had a dream where the sun the moon and the eleven stars bowed down to him.

Guernica is a world-famous painting by Spanish artist Pablo Picasso in 1937. It is one of the world's greatest anti-war paintings. It is a very large painting (a mural) which shows the bombing of the Spanish city of Guernica in 1937 during the Spanish War. It shows how people, as well as animals, all suffer because of the tragedies of war.



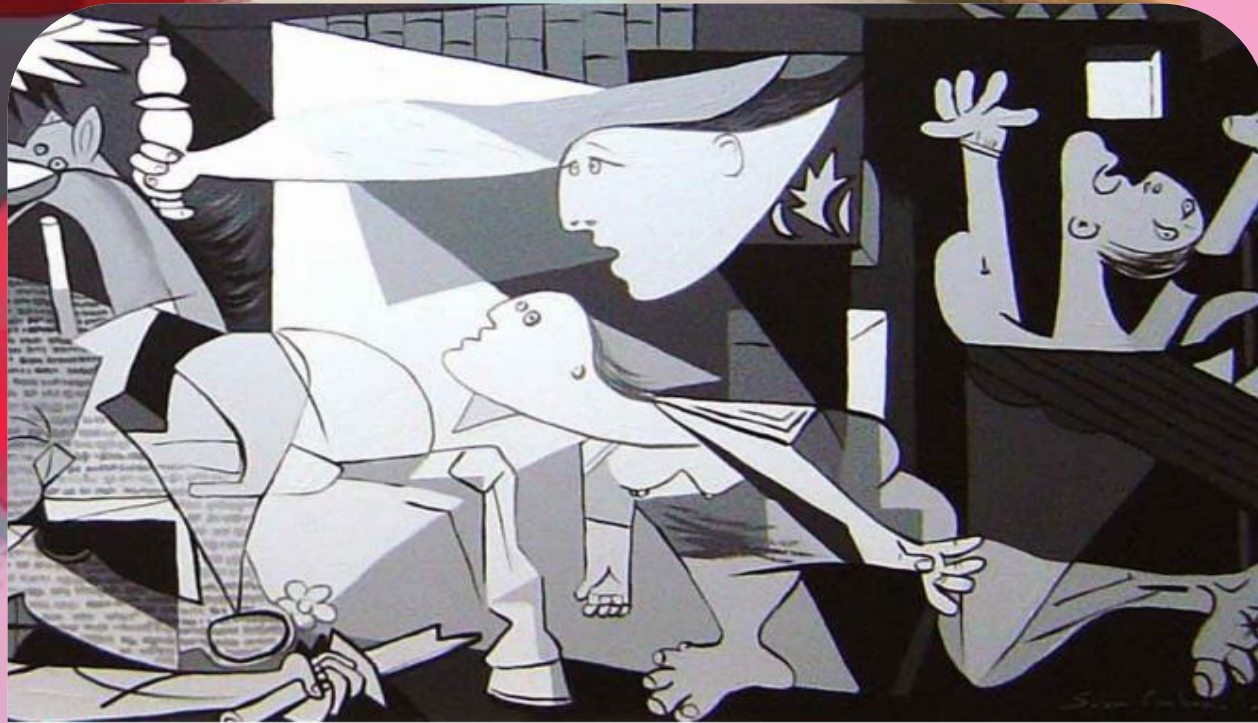
Quick Facts:

-  The Guernica is blue, black and white, 3.5 metre tall and 7.8 metre wide.
-  There are some hidden images in the painting. If you look closely at the horse's teeth and nostril, you can see a skull. Also, a bull is formed from the bent leg of the horse.
-  The painting is exhibited in Museo Reina Sofía in Madrid, Spain.
