A curved line is a type of line that does not follow a straight path.



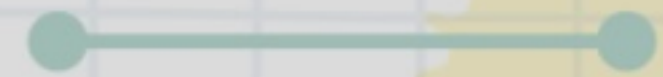
Ray:

A part of a line that has one endpoint and extends infinitely in one direction.



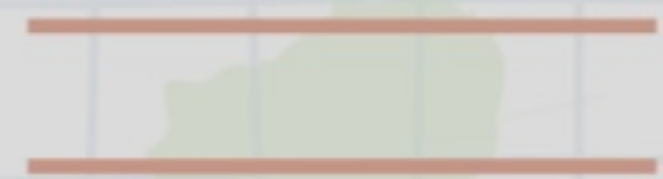
Line Segment:

A part of a line that has two endpoints.



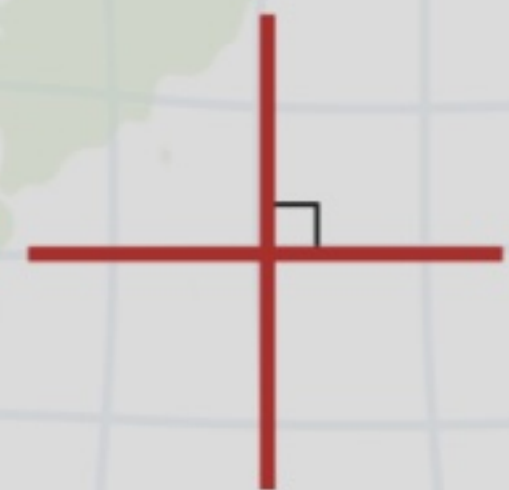
Parallel Lines:
