

large - largest

happy - happiest


crazy - craziest

## Superlatives: Short adjectives

Short adjectives	Spelling rules	Examples
Usually	+ est	slow $\rightarrow$ the slowest fast $\rightarrow$ the fastest tall $\rightarrow$ the tallest
Ending in -e	+ st	large -> the largest nice -> the nicest
Ending in a consonant + y	-y → -i + est	hungry → the hungriest happy → the happiest funny → the funniest
Ending in a vowel + a consonant	double the consonant + est	big → the biggest fat → the fattest fit → the fittest


