Sub+ helping verb (is/am/are) + 1<sup>st</sup> + ing+ object He is crying.



Sub + helping verb+ not + 1<sup>st</sup> + ing + object He is not crying.

- With the verb be, we put the adverb after the verb and before the adjective.
   Are you sometimes tired after school?

Yes, I'm often tired. / No, I'm not often tired.

 With other verbs in the present simple, we put the adverb before the main verb.

Do you often play hockey at school? Yes, I often play hockey. / No, I don't often play hockey.

Remember, we use never with positive verbs.
 I never go snowboarding. (not I don't never go...)
