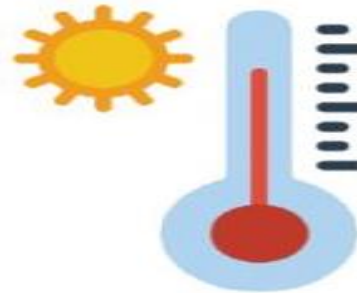

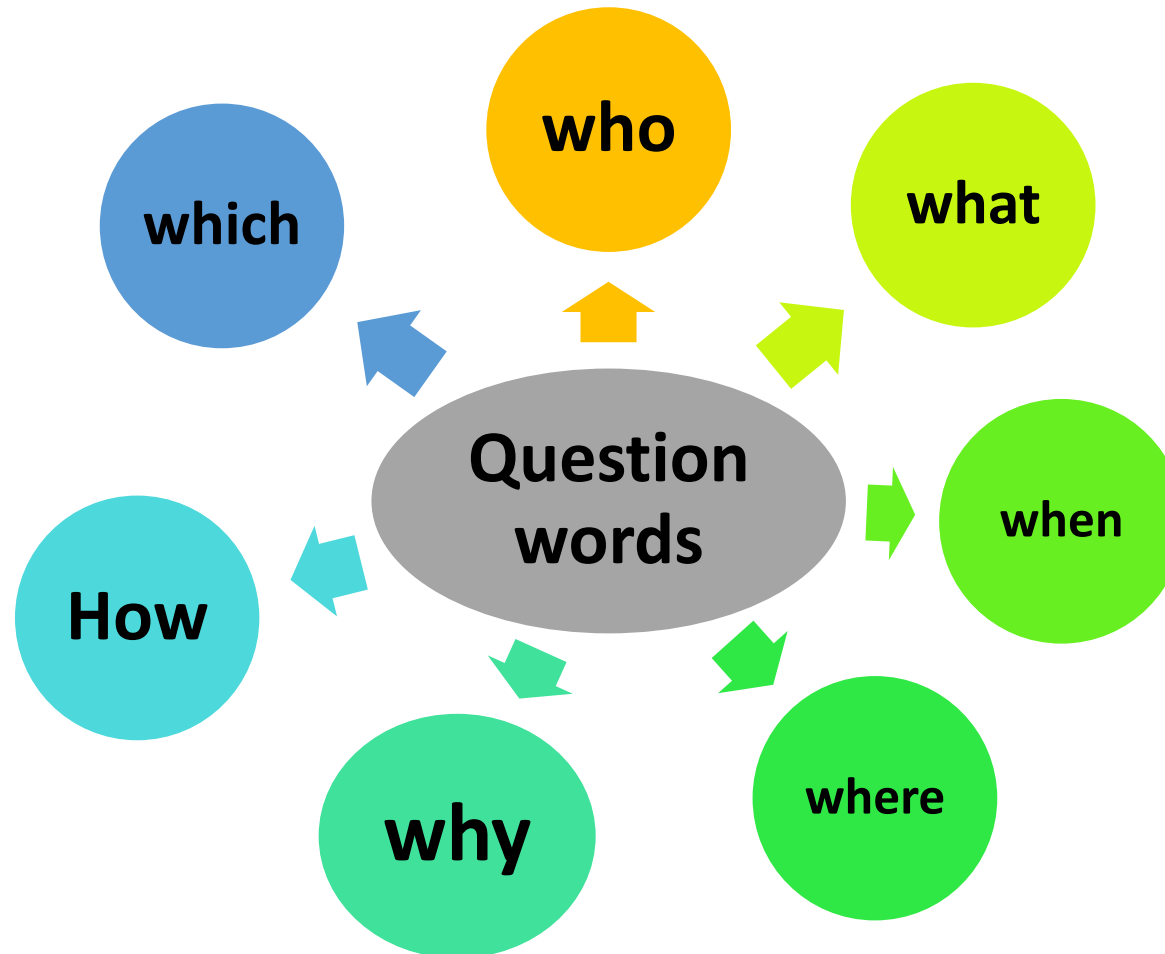

He **wasn't** thirsty.  
She **wasn't** a teacher.
