Short adjective + EST. old \rightarrow the oldest young \rightarrow the youngest CVC + EST (the final consonant is doubled) big \rightarrow the biggest hot \rightarrow the hottest Short adjective ended in $-Y \rightarrow -\text{IEST}$ easy \rightarrow the easiest heavy \rightarrow the heaviest

Long adjective: THE MOST + long adjective


exciting → the most exciting beautiful → the most beautiful Irregular adjectives good → the best bad → the worst

We use THE before the superlative form of the adjective.
