

We use the superlative to compare more than two people, places or things.

big – bigger – the biggest



# HOW DO WE BUILT?

Short adjective + EST.

old → **the oldest**

young → **the youngest**

CVC + EST (the final consonant is doubled)

big → **the biggest**

hot → **the hottest**

Short adjective ended in -Y → -IEST

easy → **the easiest**

heavy → **the heaviest**

Long adjective: THE MOST + long adjective

exciting → **the most** exciting

beautiful → **the most** beautiful

Irregular adjectives

good → **the best**

bad → **the worst**

We use THE before the superlative form of the adjective.

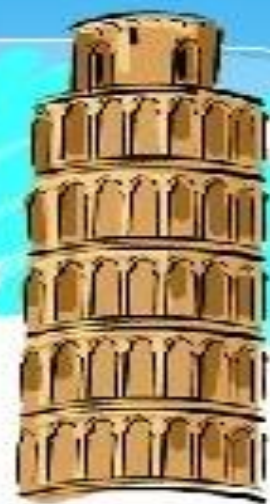
John is **the tallest**.

A Ferrari is **the most** expensive car .

old – **older** – **the oldest**



**Big Ben is old.**



**The tower is older **than** Big Ben.**

**The pyramids are older **than** the tower.**



**The pyramids are the oldest.**
