





Location

The Southern Ocean <u>surrounds</u> Antarctica, <u>extending</u> from the Antarctic <u>coastline</u> to about 60 degrees south <u>latitude</u>.





- 1. Surround: If one thing surrounds another, it is situated all round it.
- 2. Extend = continue
- 3. Coastline: outline of a coast
- 4. Latitude = width



Important Characteristics

It's the smallest and coldest ocean, characterized by strong winds, icebergs, and extreme conditions.





extreme conditions = very bad situation



Important Animals

The Southern Ocean is <u>rich in</u> marine life, including various species of seals, penguins, whales (like the blue whale).











Location

The Arctic Ocean is located around the North Pole, bordered by northern North America, Europe, and Asia.

bordered = surrounded



Important Characteristic

It's the smallest and <u>shallowest</u> ocean, covered by sea ice for much of the year. The Arctic is experiencing <u>rapid</u> climate change, resulting in <u>shrinking</u> ice cover.



Shallowest ≠ deepest

Rapid = fast

Shrink = melt

Important Animals

The Arctic Ocean is home to polar bears, walruses, seals, and various species of whales and seabirds that are adapted to cold environments. It also supports unique ecosystems that exist around the sea ice.
