

Regular Verbs Rule 1

To make the past tense with most regular verbs, add -ed.



watch watched





















Regular Verbs Rule 2


If a regular verb ends in e, just add -d.

Regular Verbs Rule 3


If a regular verb ends in a <u>consonant</u> and <u>-y</u>, take off the <u>y</u> and add <u>-ied</u>.






Regular Verbs


If a regular verb ends in a <u>single vowel</u> and a <u>single consonant</u>, double the consonant and add -ed.


