Affirmative sentences:

**Subject + infinitive**



I love sweets.

Negative sentences:

**Subject + do/does + not + infinitive**



I don't like ice cream.

She doesn't like cookies.

Interrogative sentences:

Do/Does + subject + infinitive



Do you do sports every day?

Does she like travelling?

# Don't forget -s



**Simple Present: Simply add -s to he/she/it**

Singular	I	buy	read	think	come	eat
	you	buy	read	think	come	eat
	he she it	buys	reads	thinks	comes	eats
Plural	you we they	buy	read	think	come	eat

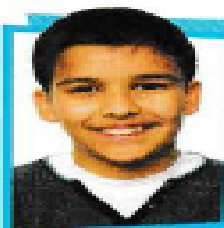
