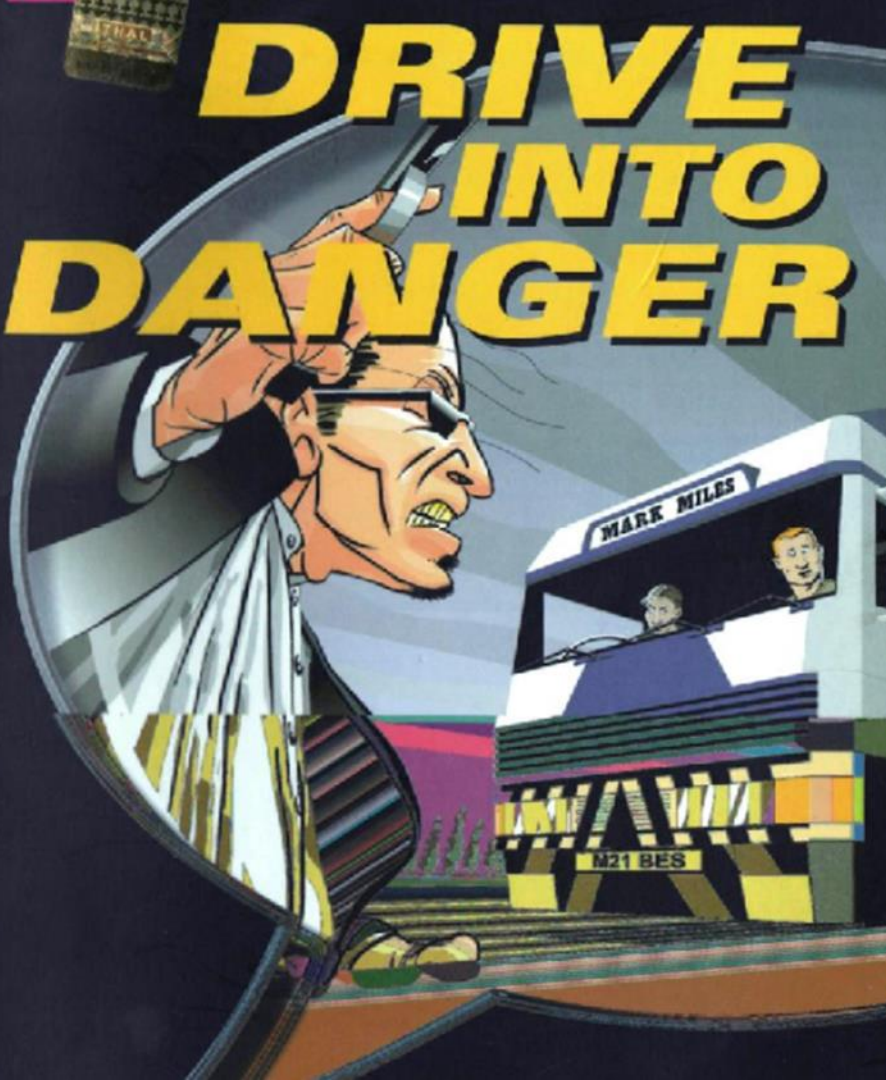

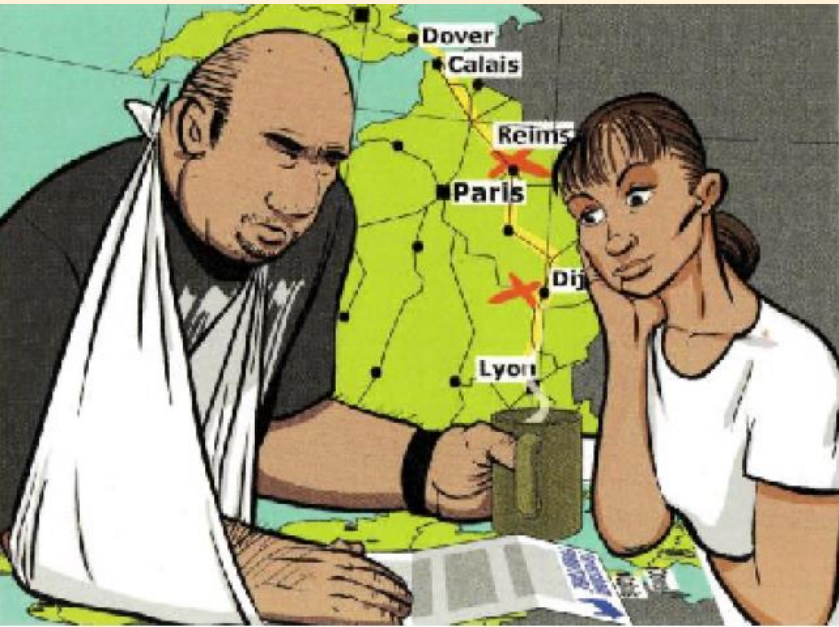

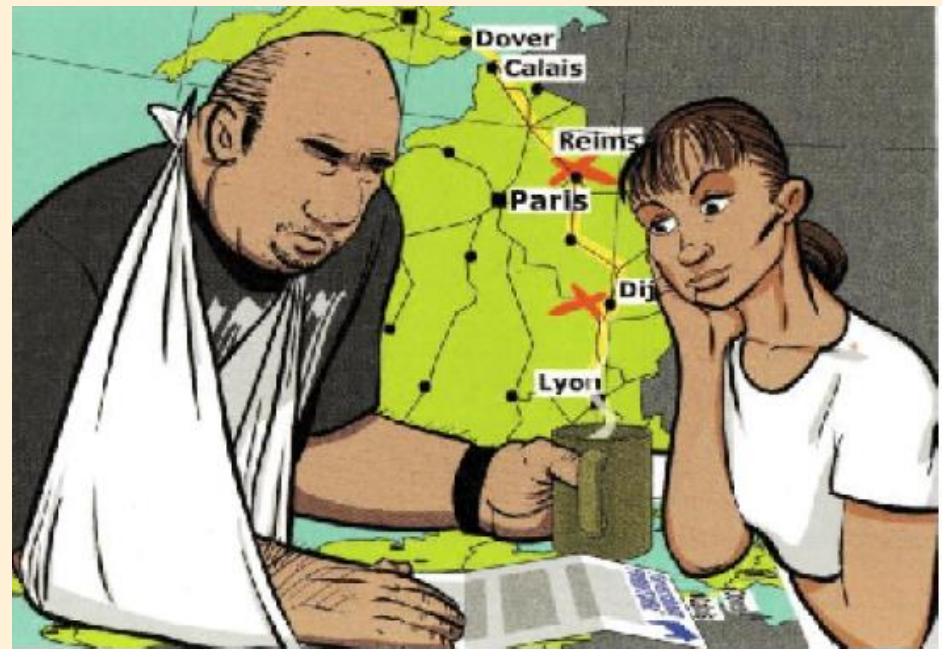




“Get the tables from the shop at Faversham,” says Gary.

45 minutes in every 4 hours.”

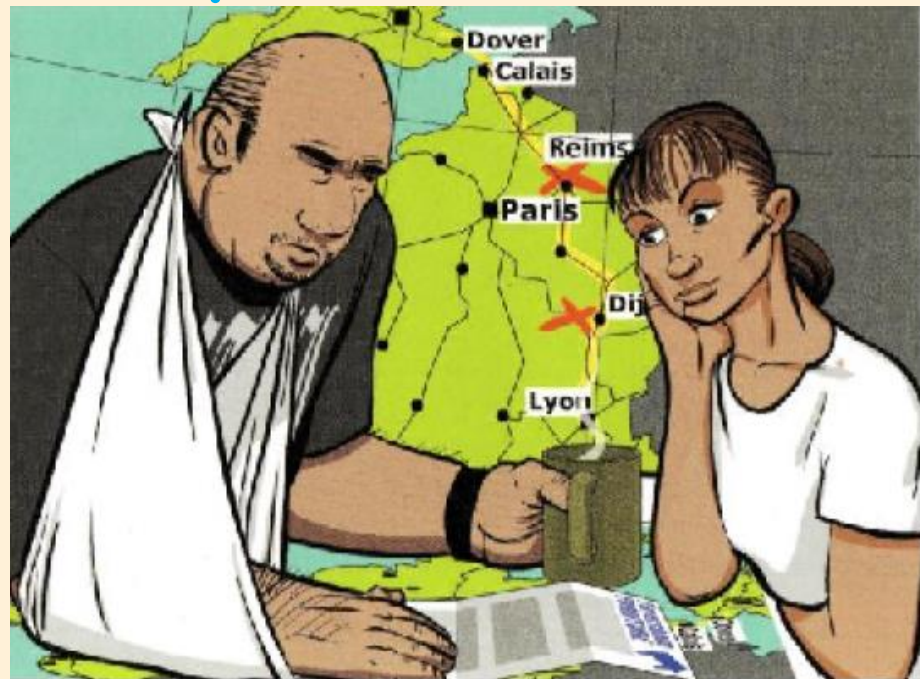
“I know.” says Kim.

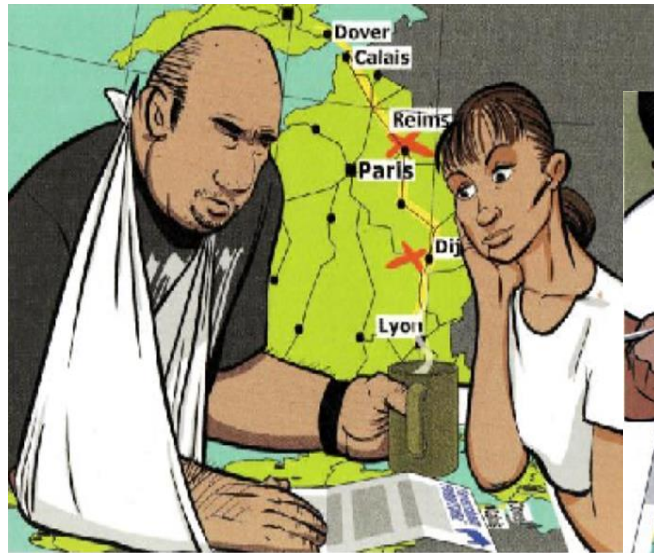

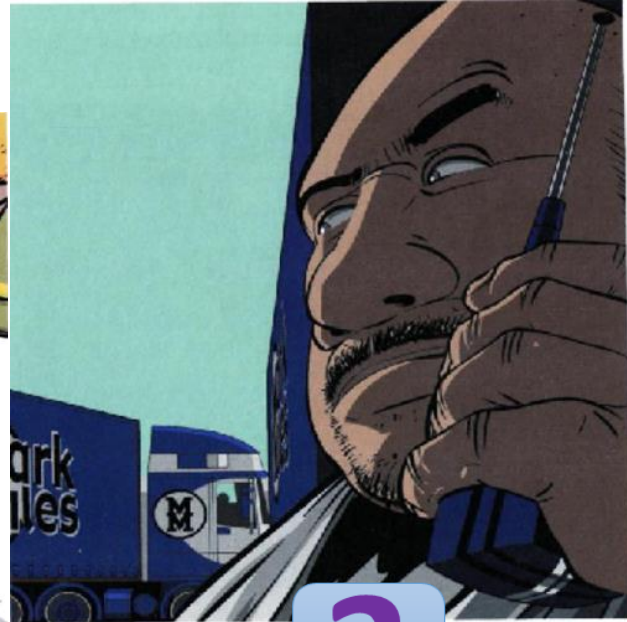
