• Live	Lived	Add –d


Spelling Rules for Regular Verbs

Base Form	<u>Past</u>	<u>Rule</u>
• Stop	Stopped	CVC; double last consonant, add –ed
• Study	Studied	Consonant + y; change y to i, add -ed

climbed: cleaned, cooked, finished, helped, joined, painted, wanted changed: completed, invited, phoned carried: copied, studied stayed: enjoyed, played stopped: planned, preferred
