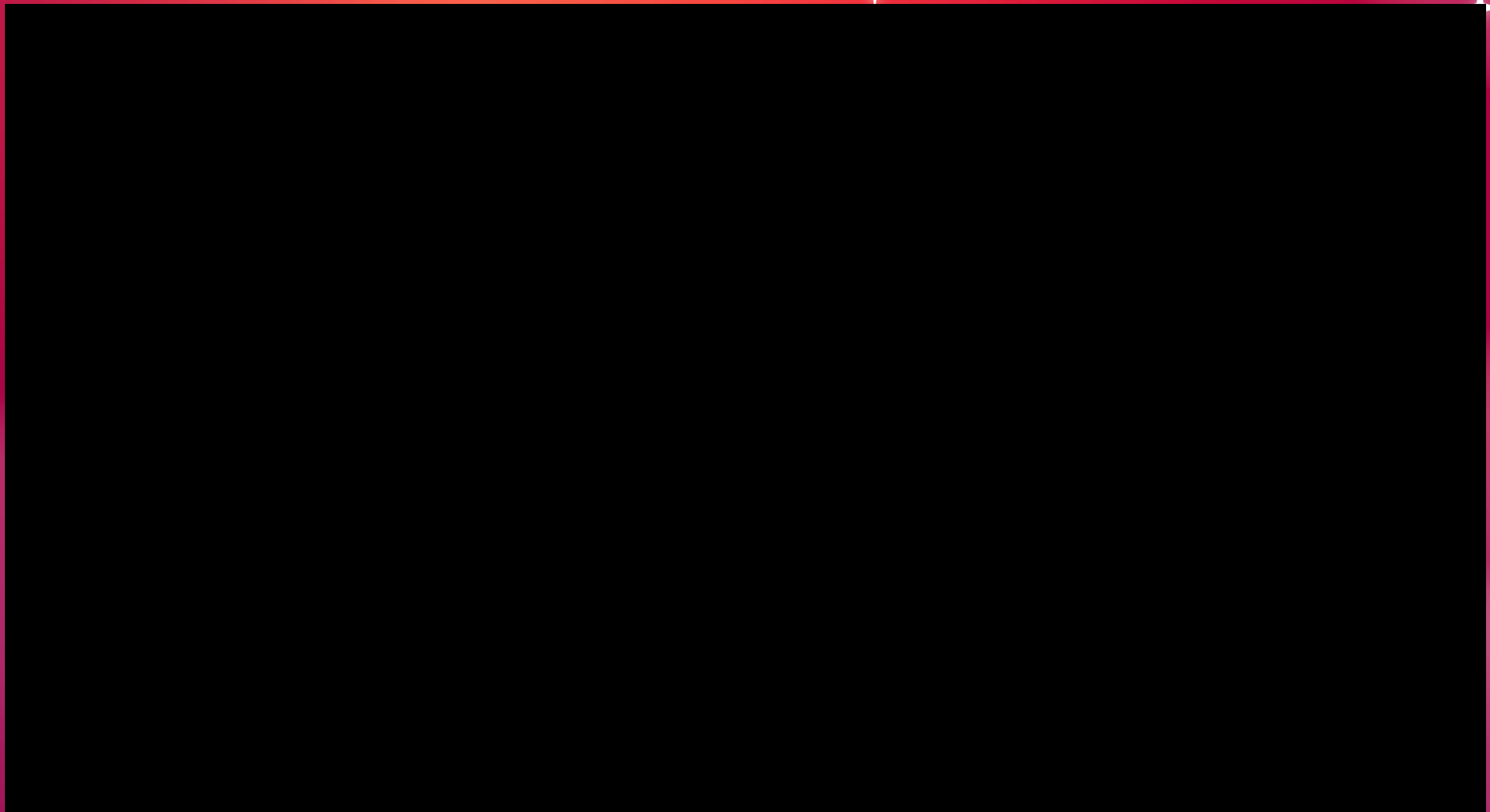

The use of leaves, branches, paints, and clothes for hiding soldiers or military equipment so that they cannot be seen against the area around them.



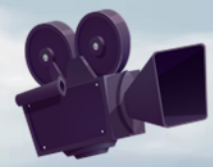

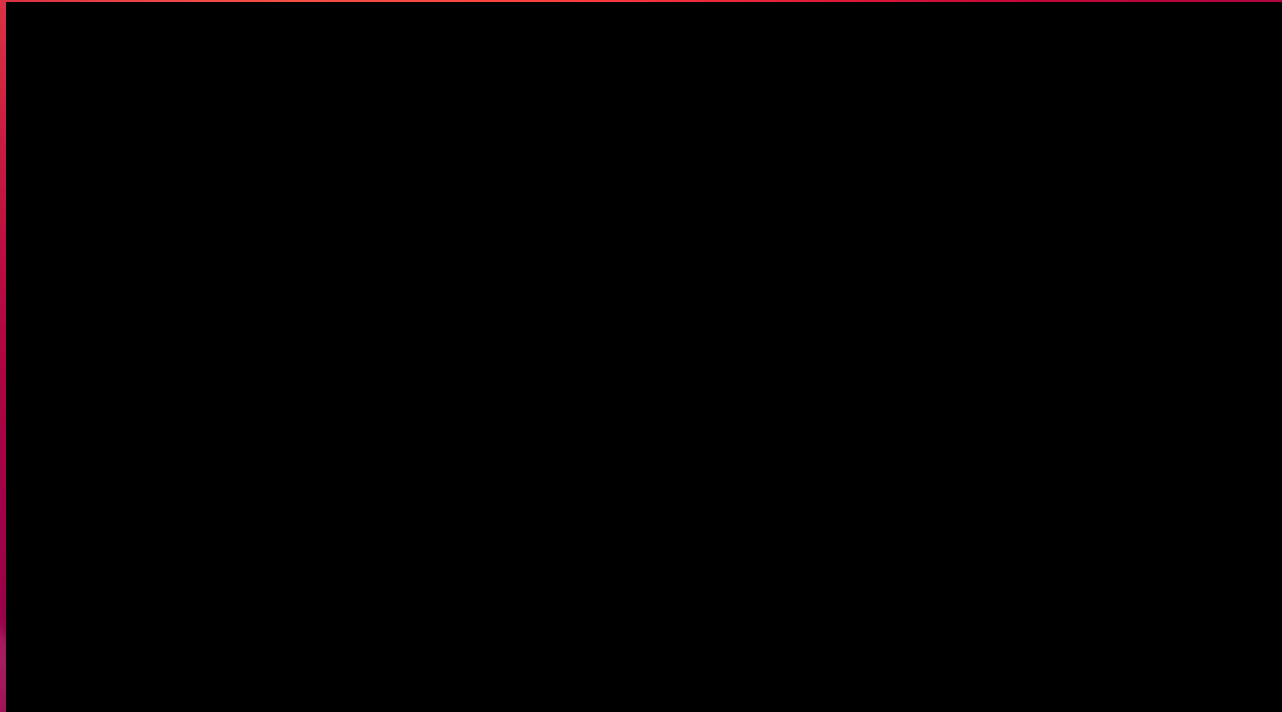
