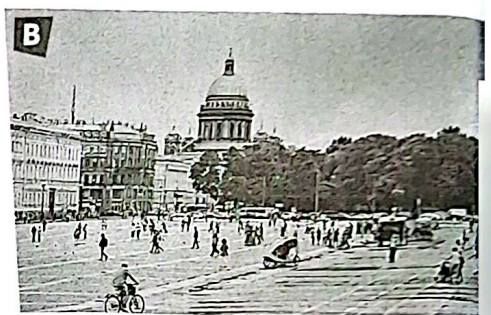
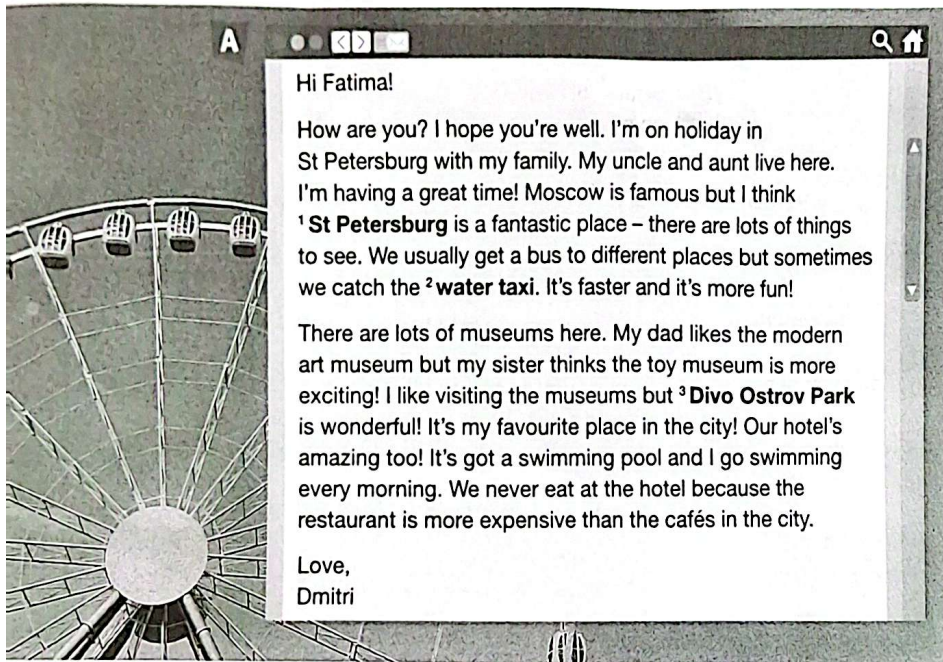

WHY I LIKE IT

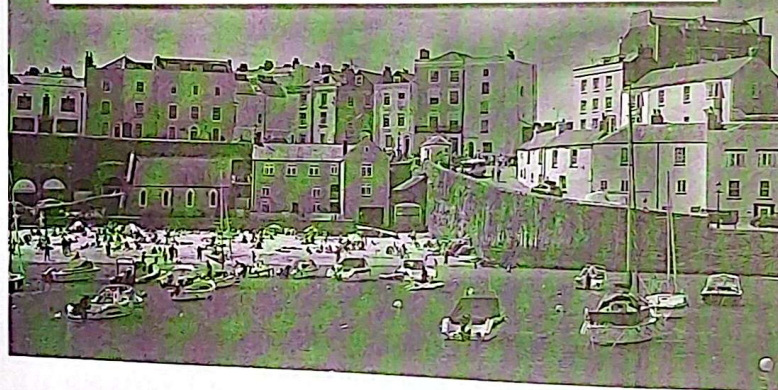
