





This is how we read mathematical equations.

Addition


$$2 + 3 = 5$$


Two plus three equals five

Subtraction


$$8 - 4 = 2$$


Eight minus four equals two.

Multiplication


$$2 \times 3 = 6$$

Two times three equals six.
Two multiplied by three equals six.

Division


$$4 \div 2 = 2$$

Four divided by two equals two.

$$2^5 = 2 \times 2 \times 2 \times 2 \times 2 = 32$$

Two to the power of five equals thirty two.

$4^2 = 16$: Four squared equals sixteen

$4^3 = 64$: Four cubed equals sixty four

$$2 \times (\text{Length} + \text{Width})$$

Two times open parenthesis length plus width close parenthesis.

Two times the sum of the length and width.

$$\frac{1}{2} \times \text{Base} \times \text{Height}$$

one-half times base times height
