Bats

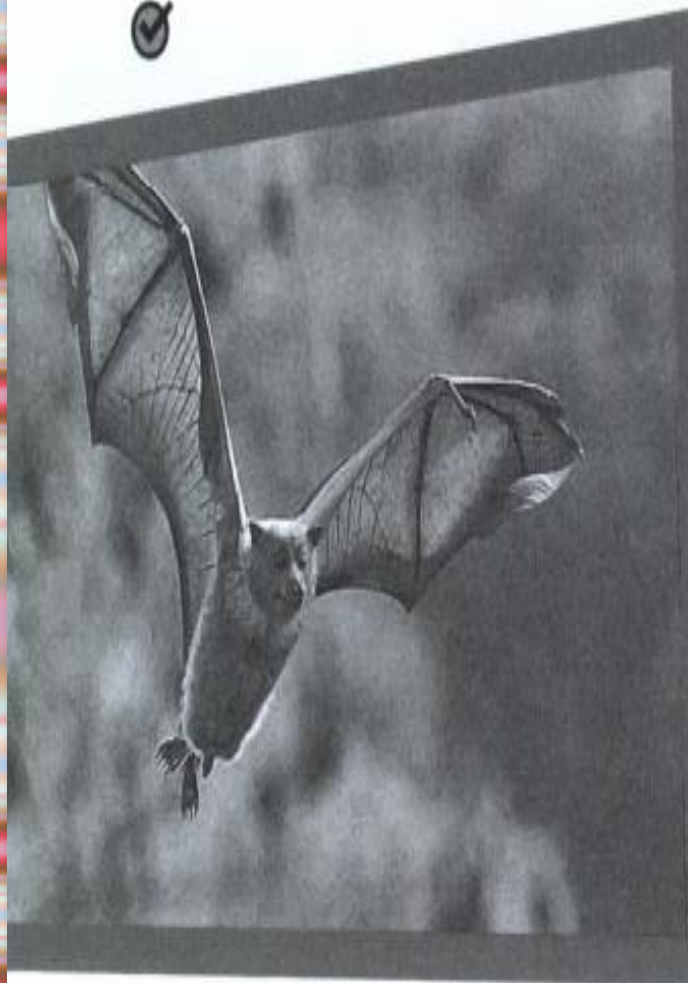
