We use A or AN with singular nouns.

A is used when a noun starts with a consonant sound;

e.g. A dog, a book, etc. **AN** is used when a noun starts with a vowel sound; e.g. An apple, an hour, etc.

We use **SOME** with countable nouns (only with their plural) and with uncountable nouns.

**SOME** is used in:

- \* positive sentences;
- e.g. I have got some time.
- \* questions, expressing requests and

E.g. Would you like some tea? Can I have some biscuits? We use **ANY** with countable nouns (only with their plural) and with uncountable nouns.

**ANY** is used in:

- \* negative sentences;
- e.g. I haven't got any time.
- \* general questions;
- e.g. Have you got any sisters? Is there any tea left?
