If a verb ends in a single e, drop the e and add -ing.










































Verbs Ending In ie

If a verb ends in ie, change ie for y and add -ing.






















Verbs Ending In A Consonant Which Comes After A Vowel.


If a verb ends in a consonant, and the letter before the consonant is a vowel, double the consonant and add -ing. (Note: This does not apply to verbs ending in w/x/y.)
