Verbs Ending In A Consonant Which Comes After A Vowel.

If a verb ends in a consonant, and the letter before the consonant is a vowel, **double the consonant** and add **-ing**.

(Note: This does not apply to verbs ending in w/x/y.)

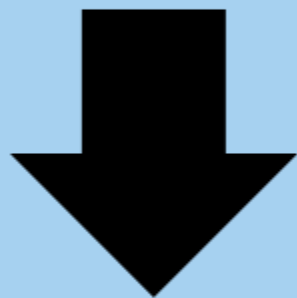

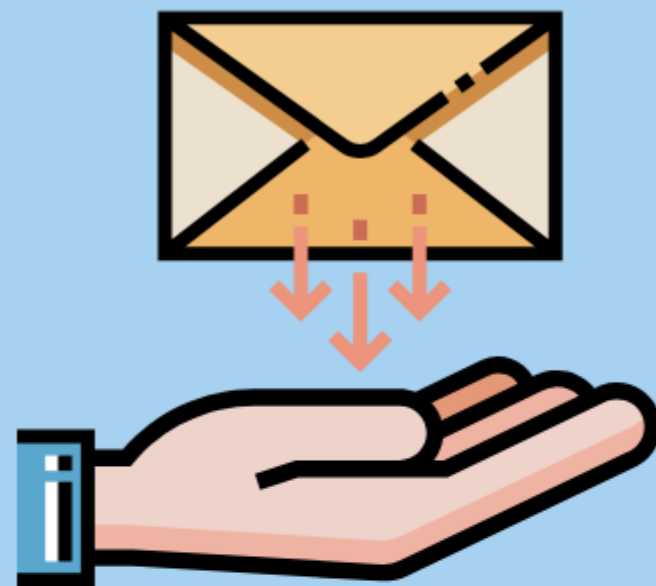
