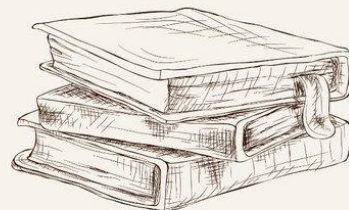
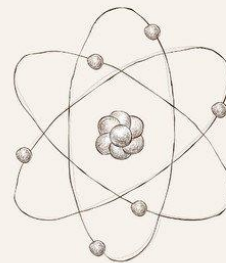

Egg Stage



**Catterpillar
stage(larva)**



- When the egg hatches, a caterpillar comes out, which is also called a larva.
- Caterpillars eat a lot and grow quickly. They munch on leaves and plants.



Chrysalis Stage (Pupa)

- After eating lots of food, the caterpillar forms a cocoon around itself called a chrysalis, or pupa.
- Big changes happen inside the chrysalis that transform the caterpillar into a butterfly.
