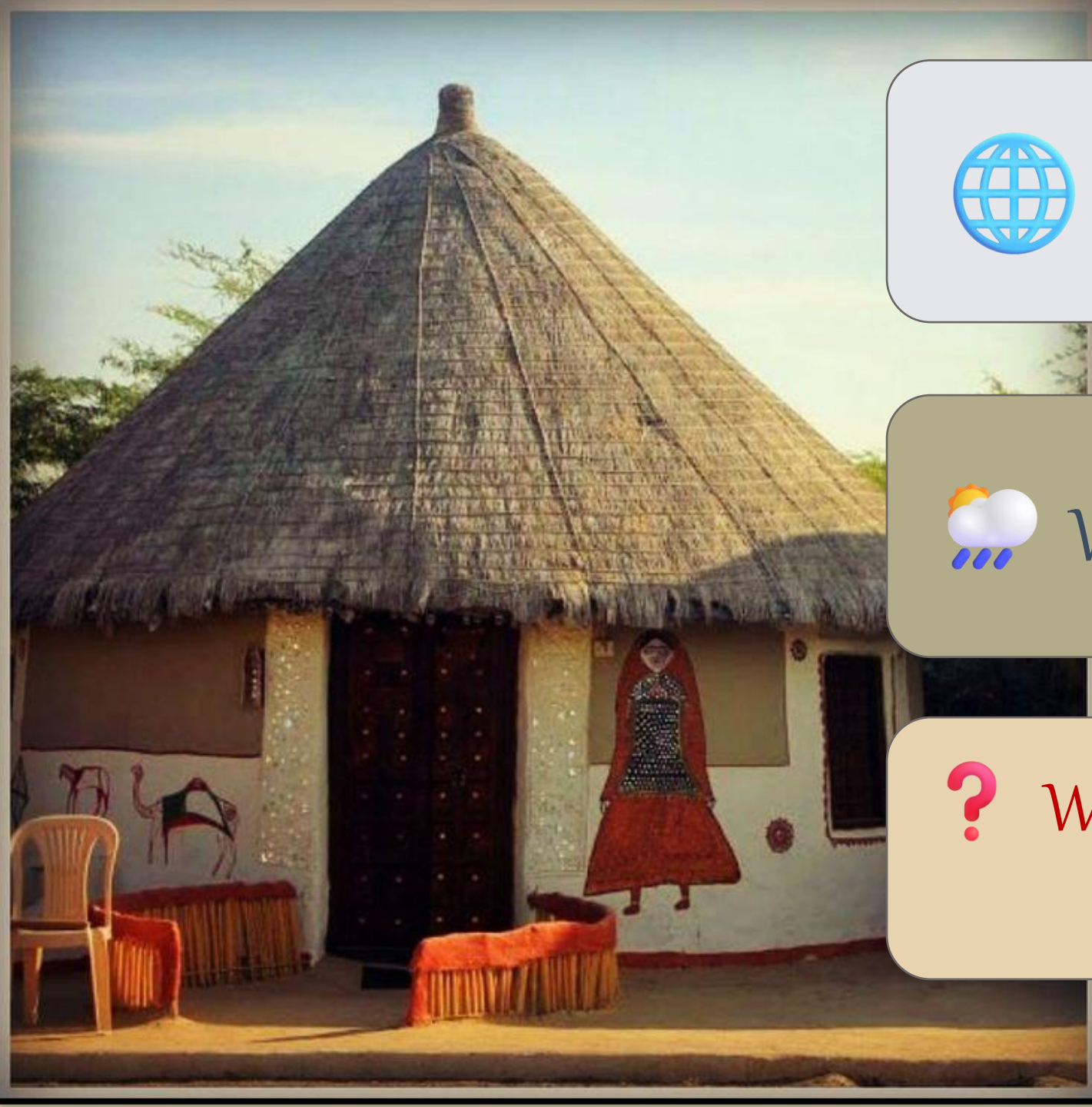

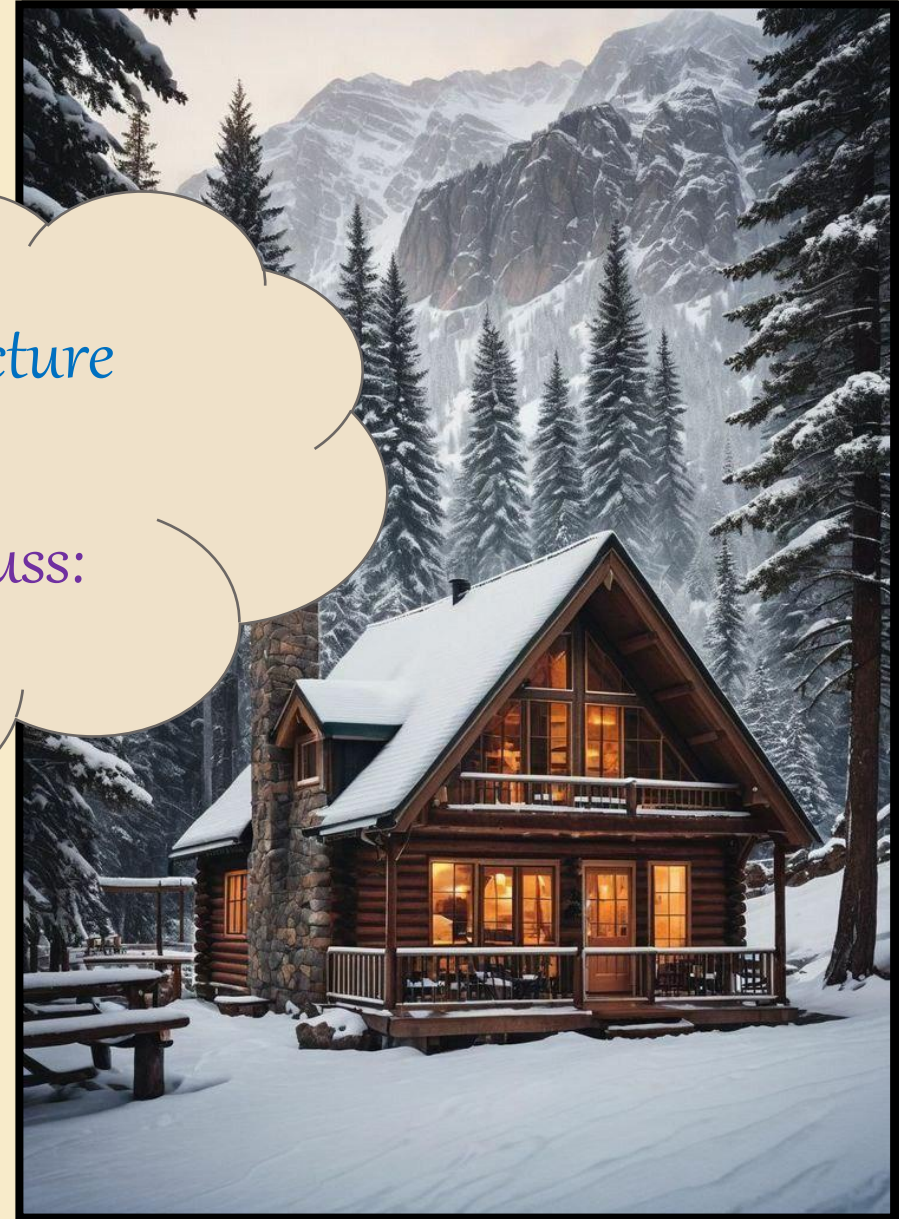

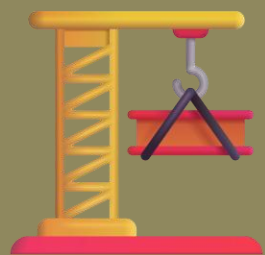

Safe (to protect people)





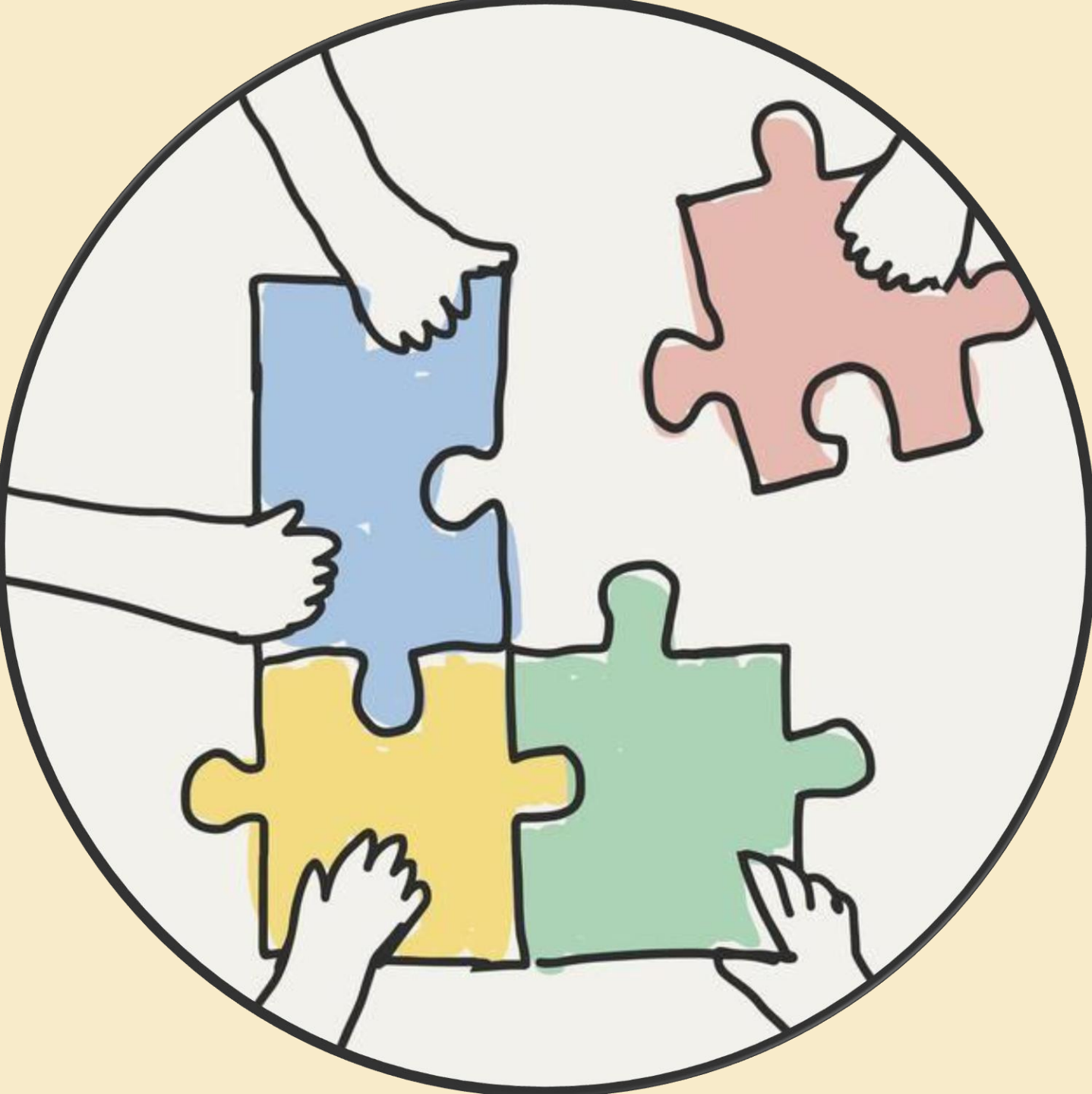
Available (easy to find nearby)

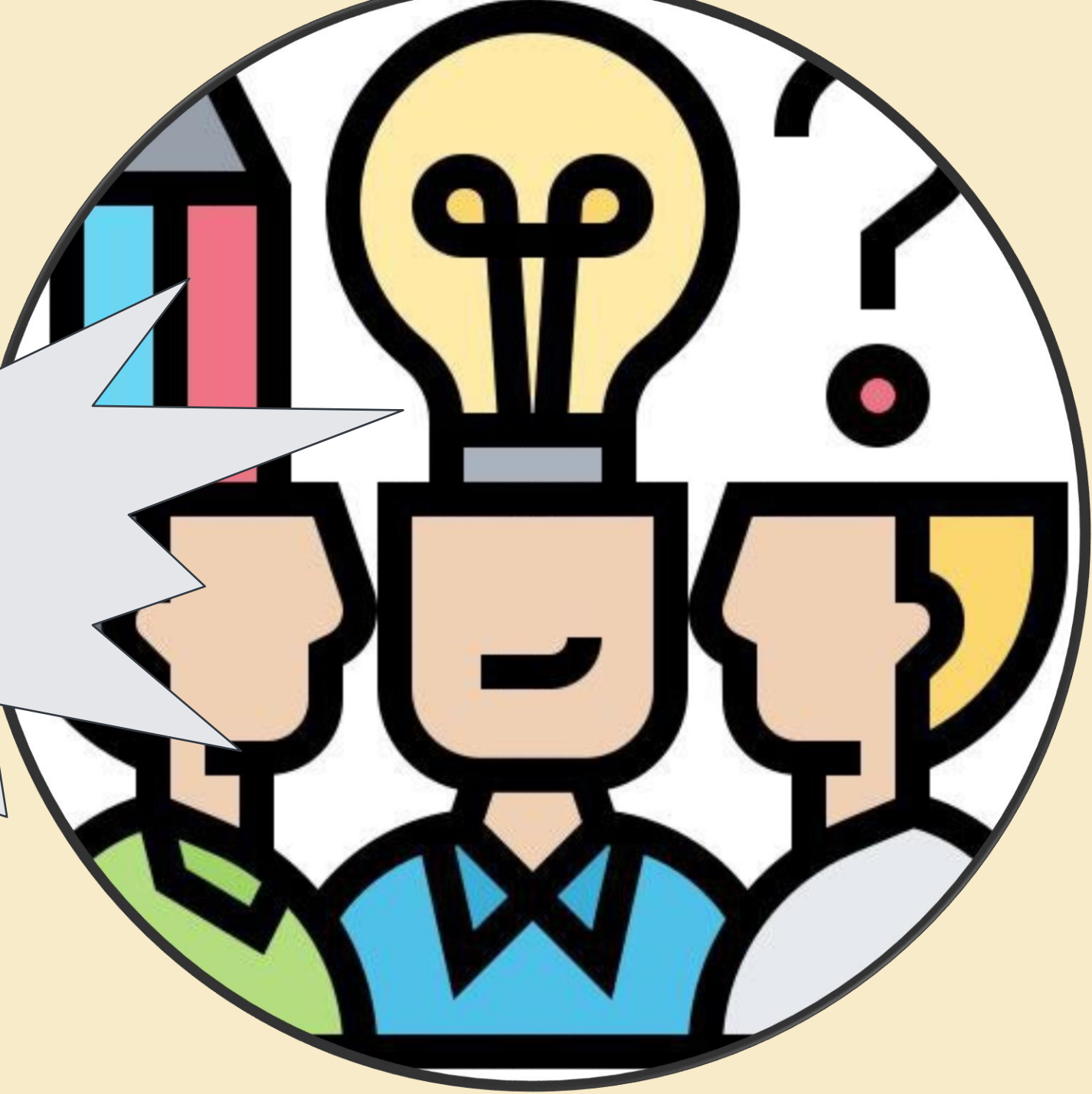
