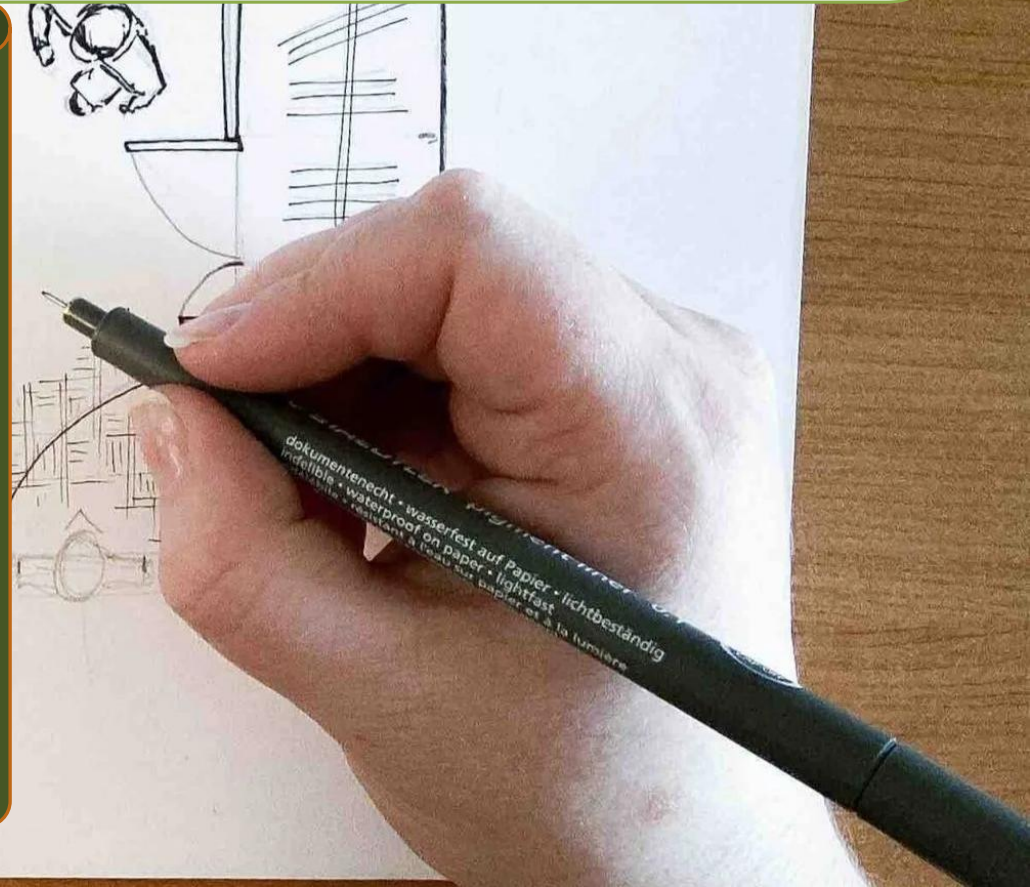






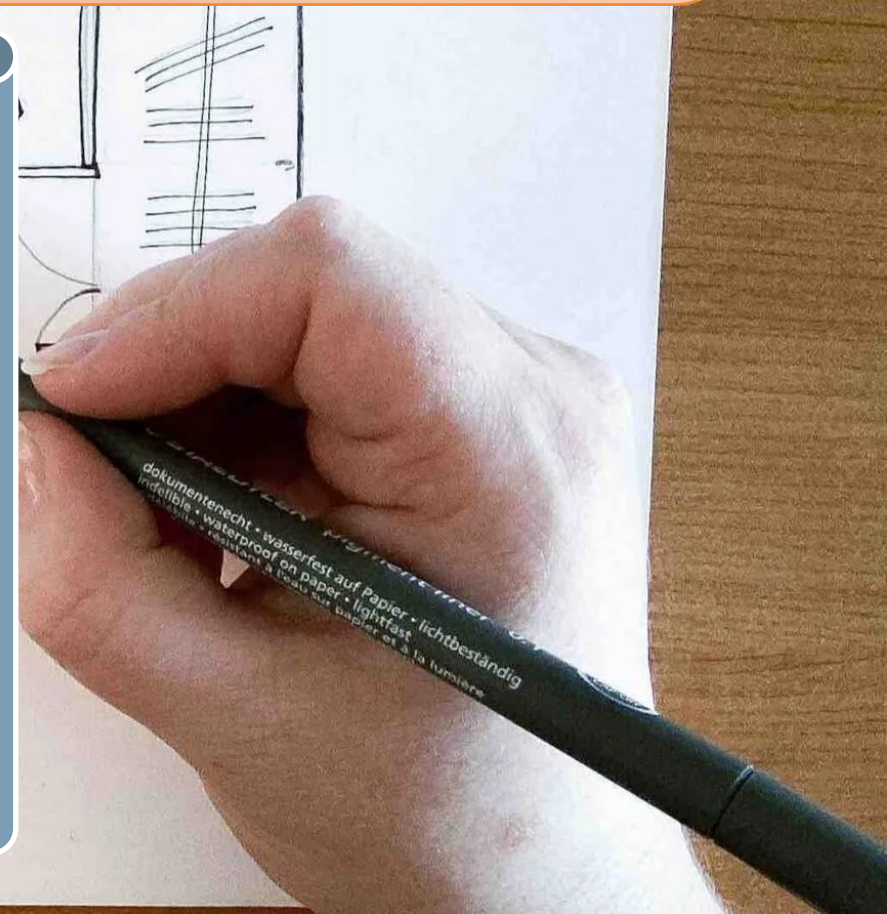
# Start with a Rectangle or Square

Use straight lines to divide the space into different rooms 🧱.





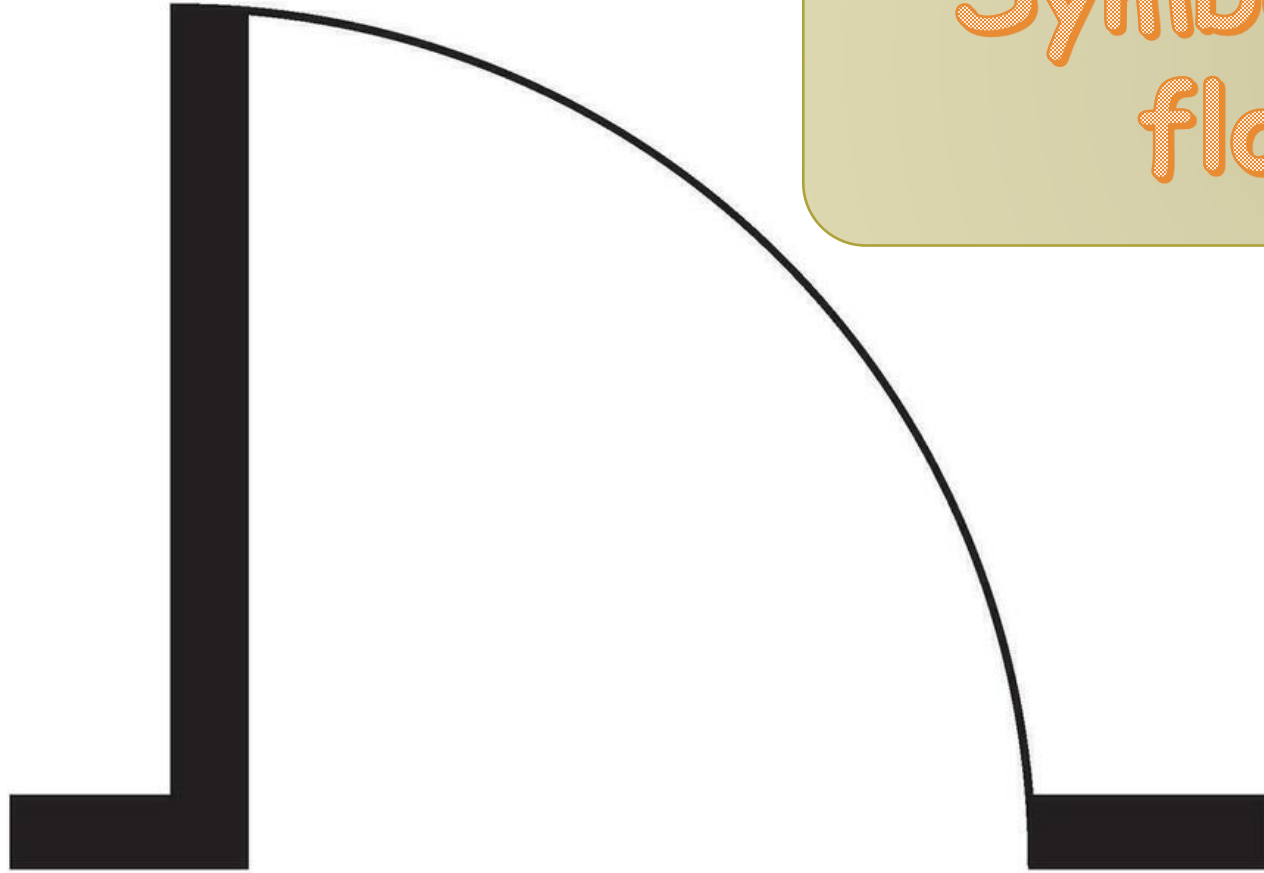
# Mark the Doors and Windows

 Door: curved line (like a slice of pizza)

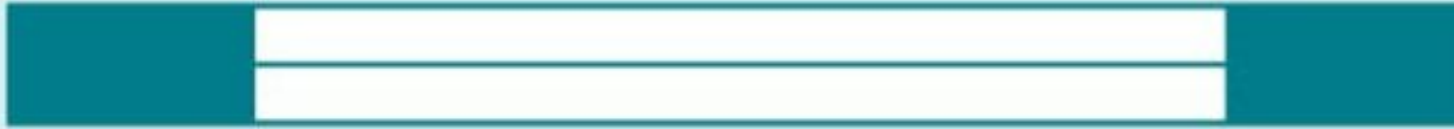
 Window: thin rectangle or line on the wall

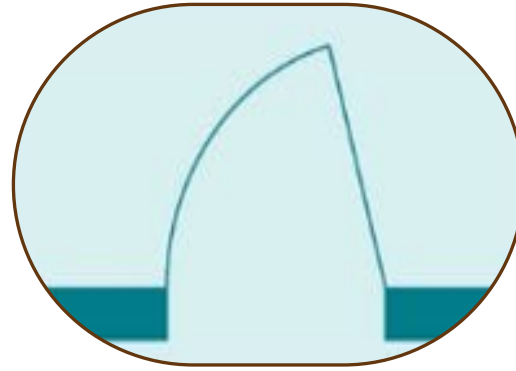
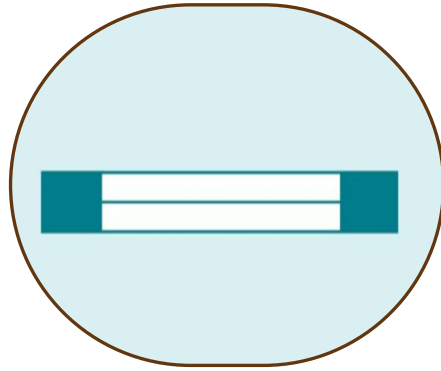
