“Is this your axe?”

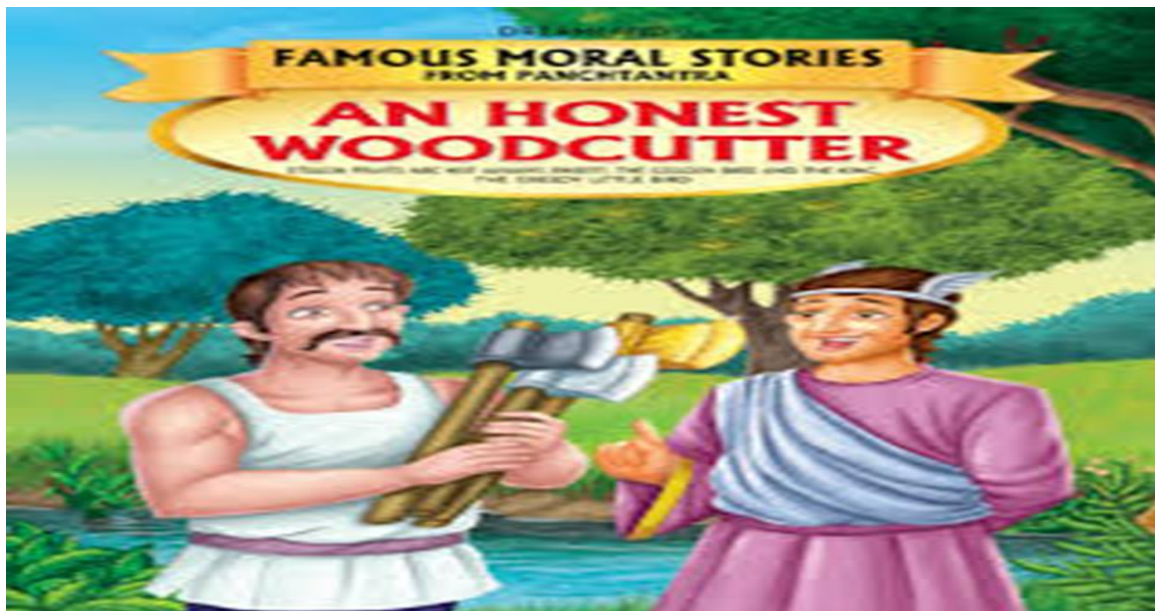
The woodcutter said, “No, that’s not mine.”

A boy looked after sheep near his village. He was bored, so he shouted,

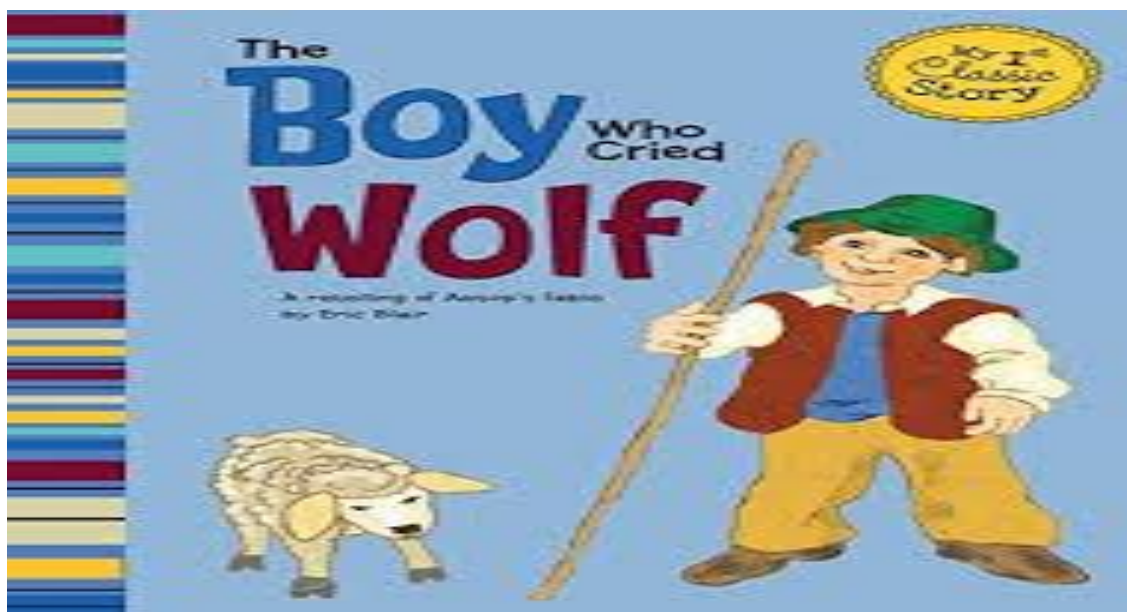
“Wolf! Wolf!” The villagers ran to help him, but there was no wolf.
