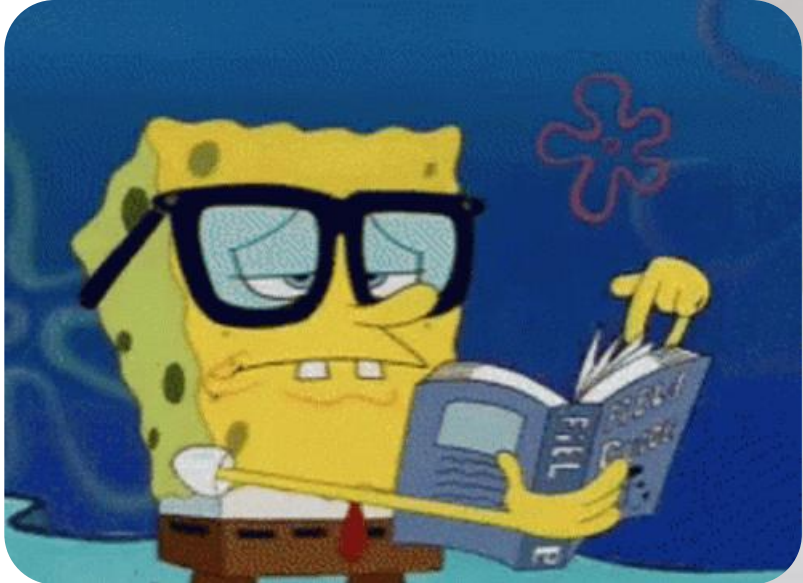

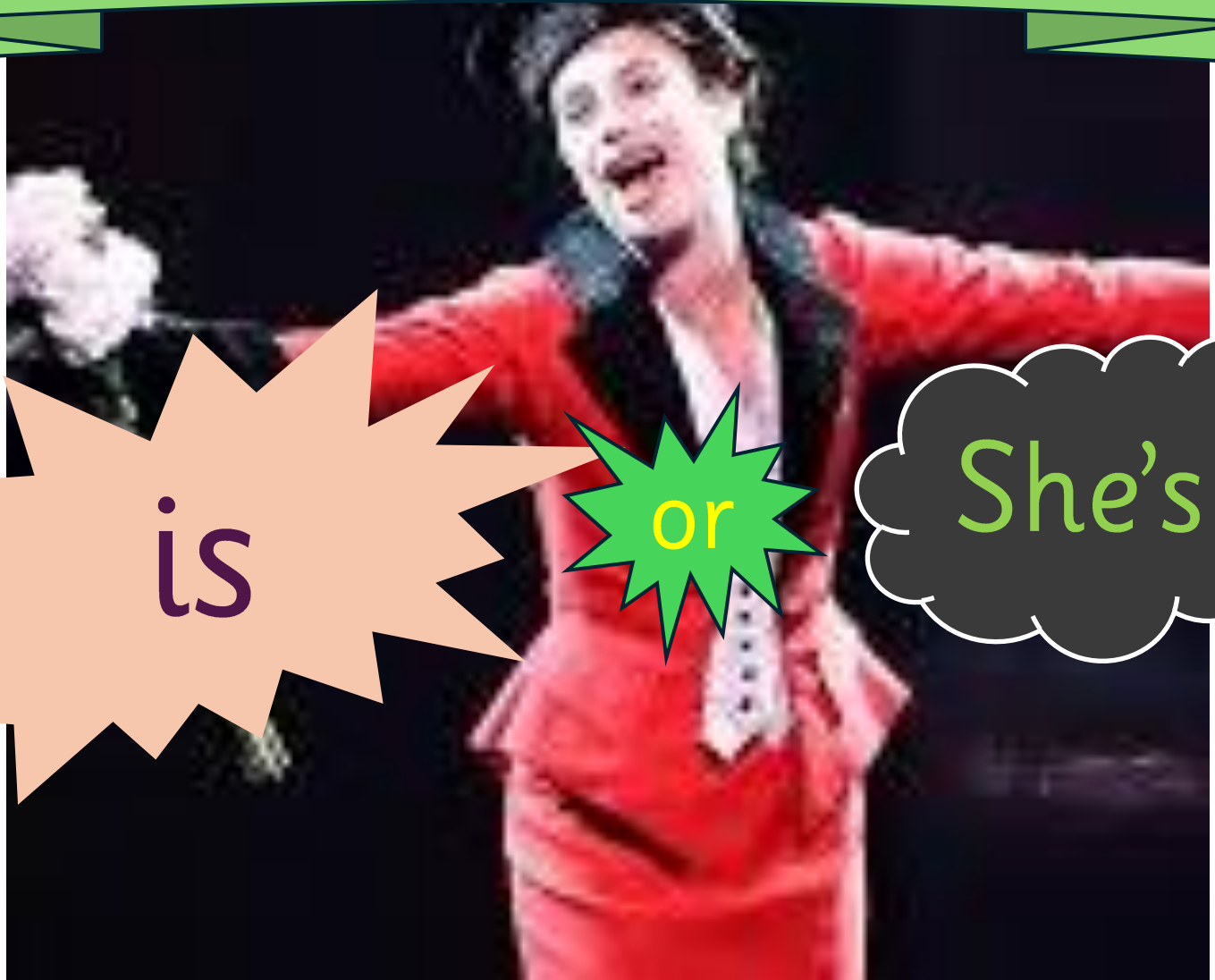

"He/She's + adjective"

To describe what someone is like



He/She's + [adjective]



Meaning: "He/She is ..."

Describing Clothing –
"He/She's wearing + noun"

Use: To describe what someone has
on right now.



He/She's wearing + [clothing item]



Meaning: "He/She is wearing

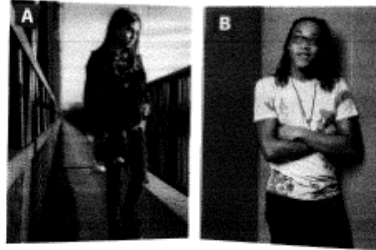
