Promises	If you help me, I'll give you a present.
Threats/ warnings	I'll tell the police if you do it again.
Logical consequences	If you don't take the umbrella, you'll get wet.
Offers	If you like, I'll help you.
Making a deal	If you clean the bathroom, I'll clean the kitchen.
