September 1620

We are a total of 102 settlers: We have to leave Europe to start a new life somewhere else. After the summer, we are ready for the voyage. We have to cross the ocean to get to North America. We are leaving England on a ship called the Mayflower.

March 1621

Some Native Americans are here to help us. We must learn how to fish and farm during the spring to have food. They are teaching us many things.

December 1620

Land! Finally we can leave the Mayflower after more than two months at sea. The voyage was horrible and dangerous. We must build some homes because winter is coming. It is very cold and foggy here in the new world and some settlers are getting ill.

November 1621

It is autumn and we have so much food now!  
We have to celebrate Thanksgiving with turkey  
and special food. We must say thank you to  
the Native Americans for all their help.
