

How to make a Yes / No question in Present perfect.

She has visited London?

Yes, she has. /No, she hasn't.

They have drunk three cups of coffee today?

Yes, they have. /No, they haven't.

Mary and Jane have gone to a new city?

Yes, they have. /No, they haven't.
