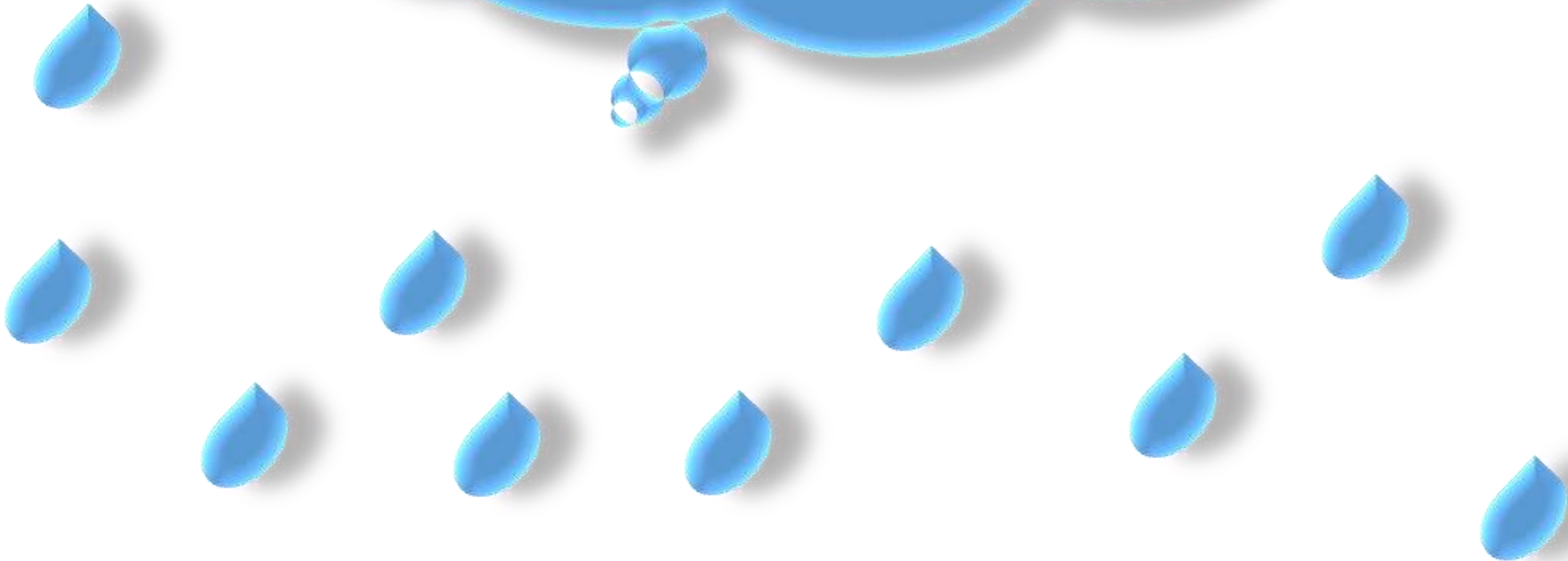

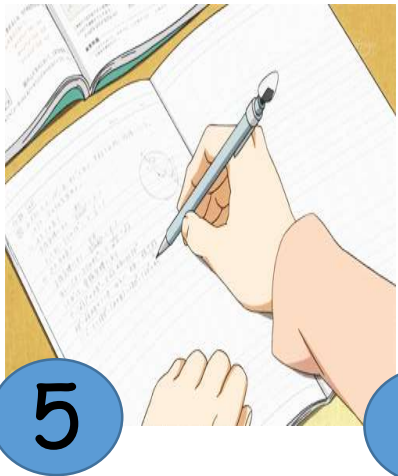

She **must** take notes in the class .



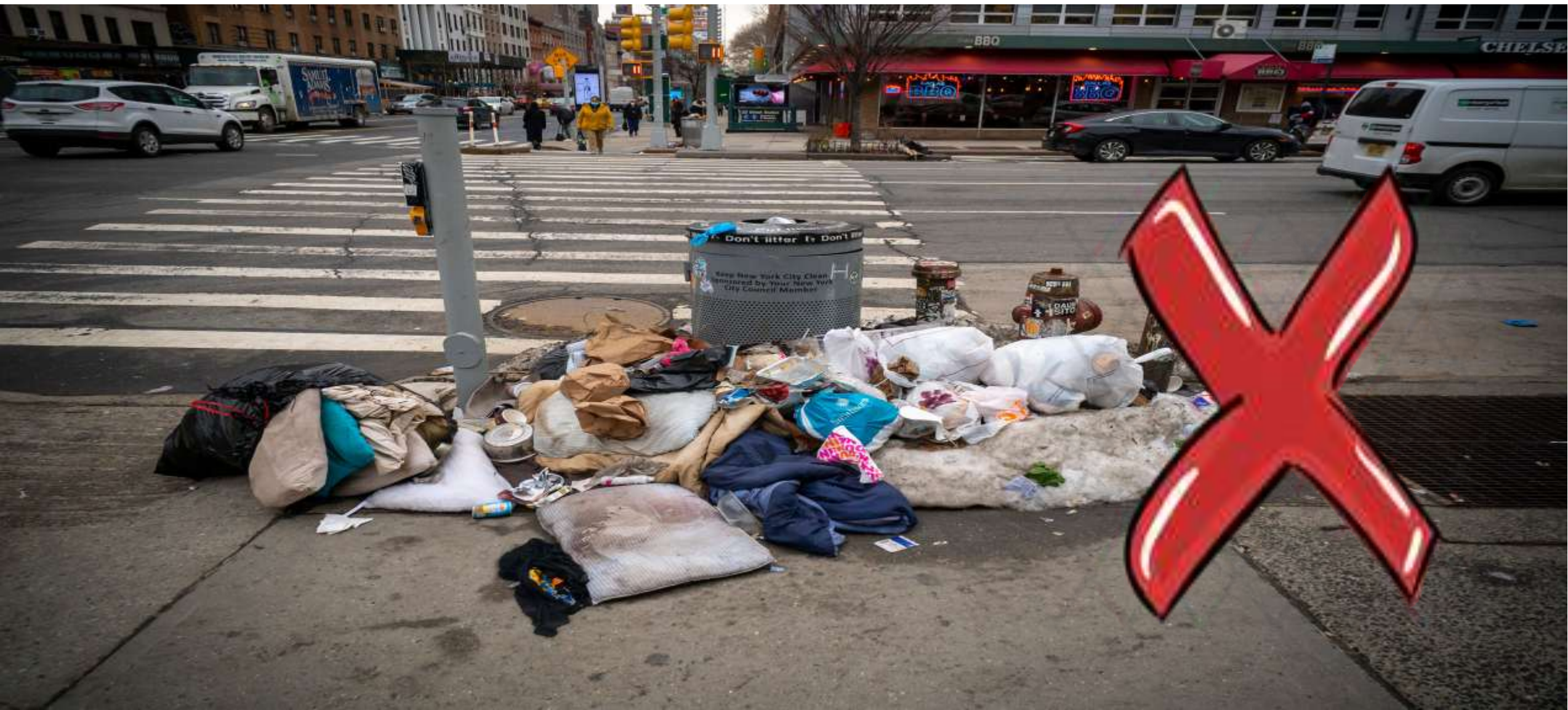
We **mustn't** be noisy in the class.

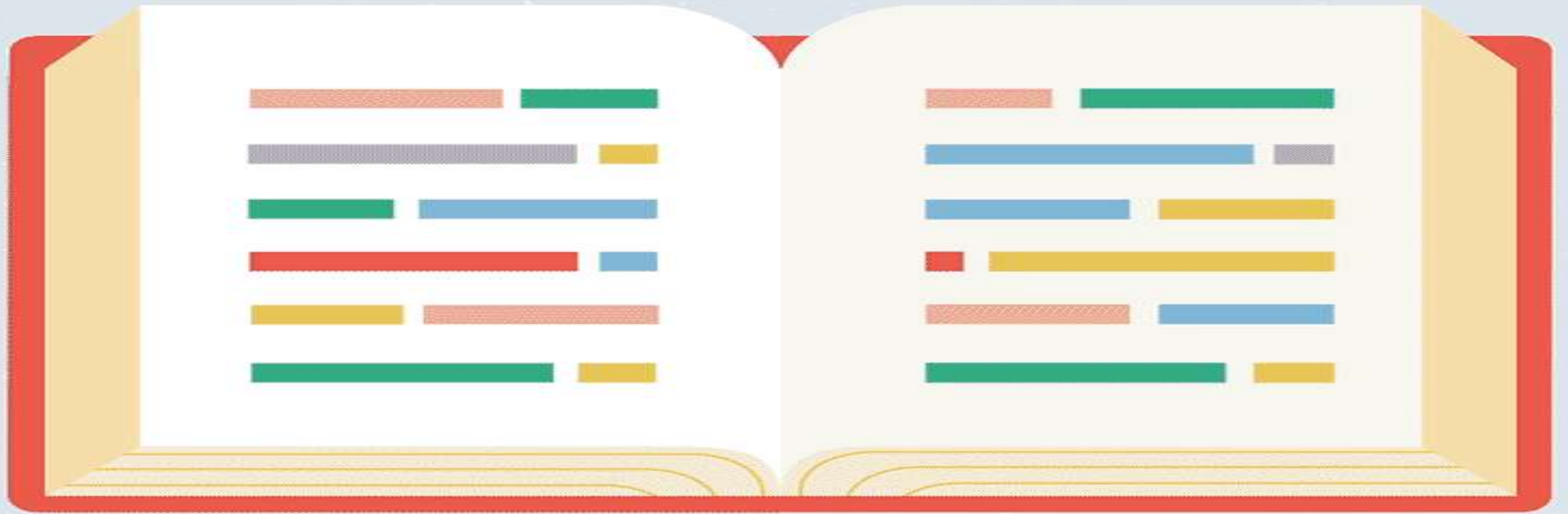
