#### Tips for Parents

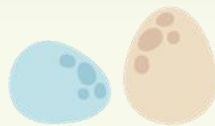
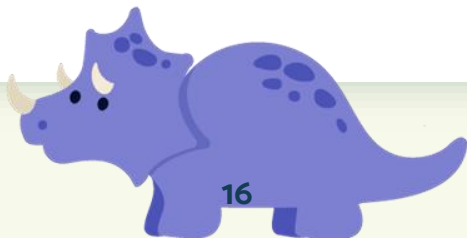
