

These are animals that eat plants. They eat a lot of leaves, grass, flowers and fruit. Some herbivores are horses, rabbits and cows.




#### Carnivores

#### **Omnivores**


These are animals that eat some plants and some meat. Some omnivores are bears and monkeys.


### Teeth


Herbivores, carnivores and omnivores have got different teeth because they eat different food.
