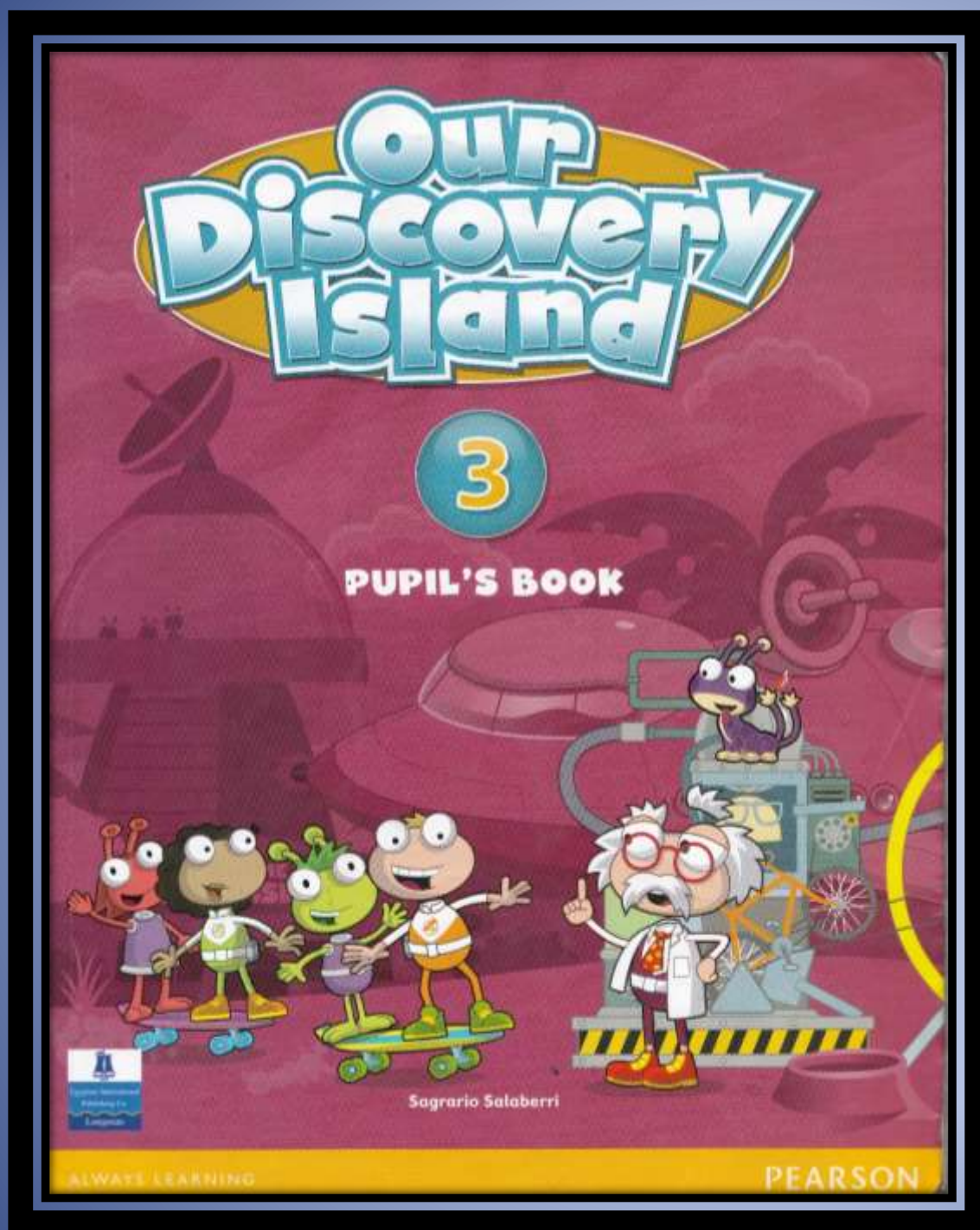

These are animals that eat some plants and some meat. Some omnivores are bears and monkeys.

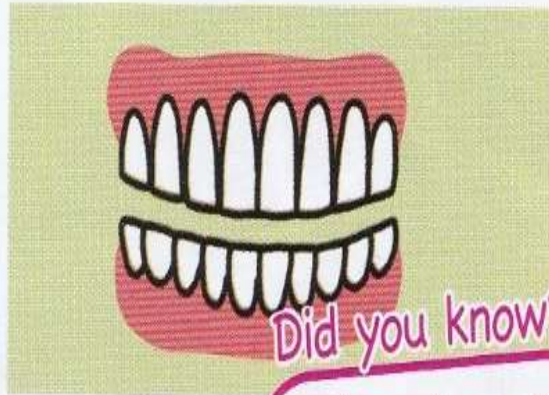

# Teeth

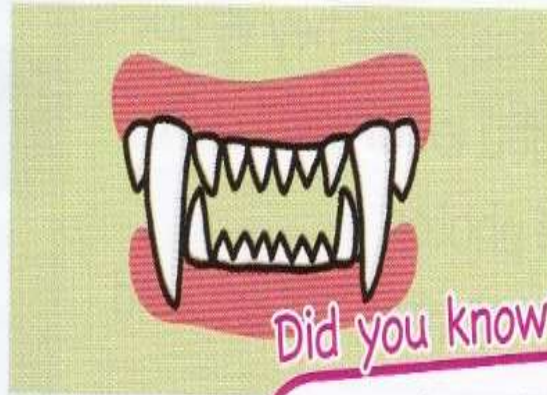
Herbivores, carnivores and omnivores have got different teeth because they eat different food.
