RELATIVE PRONOUNS



Pay attention to the following sentences:

The girl who is raising her hand is an excellent pupil.

Next to her there is a boy whose favourite task in class is talking to his partner.

There is a boy sleeping in class, which is a forbidden thing to do in class!

The boy that is standing in the middle is Paul.

The words in bold are **relative pronouns**. Relative pronouns replace nouns and also link sentences. They have the same form for singular and plural:

The girl who is raising her hand is an excellent pupil.

- The girls who are raising their hands are excellent pupils.

 who, whom and whose are only used with persons
 - which is only used with things or animals
 - that is used for things and persons
 - sometimes we can omit the relative pronoun, when it is not the subject of the verb:

e.g. The museum that I visited ... / The museum I visited
