I Louis XIV was a famous French king. He was born in 1638 and he became King when he was four years old. When he was older, Louis became a powerful leader. He wrote many new laws and created a large army. He also built the Palace of Versailles near Paris. Many people called him The Sun King. He died in 1715 when he was 80 years old.

2 Victoria was a famous British queen. She was born in 1819 and she became Queen in 1837, when she was 18 years old. Victoria married Prince Albert in 1840 and they had nine children. In 1877, Victoria became the Empress of India. During her time, Britain had the largest empire in the world. Queen Victoria died in 1901 at the age of 81.
