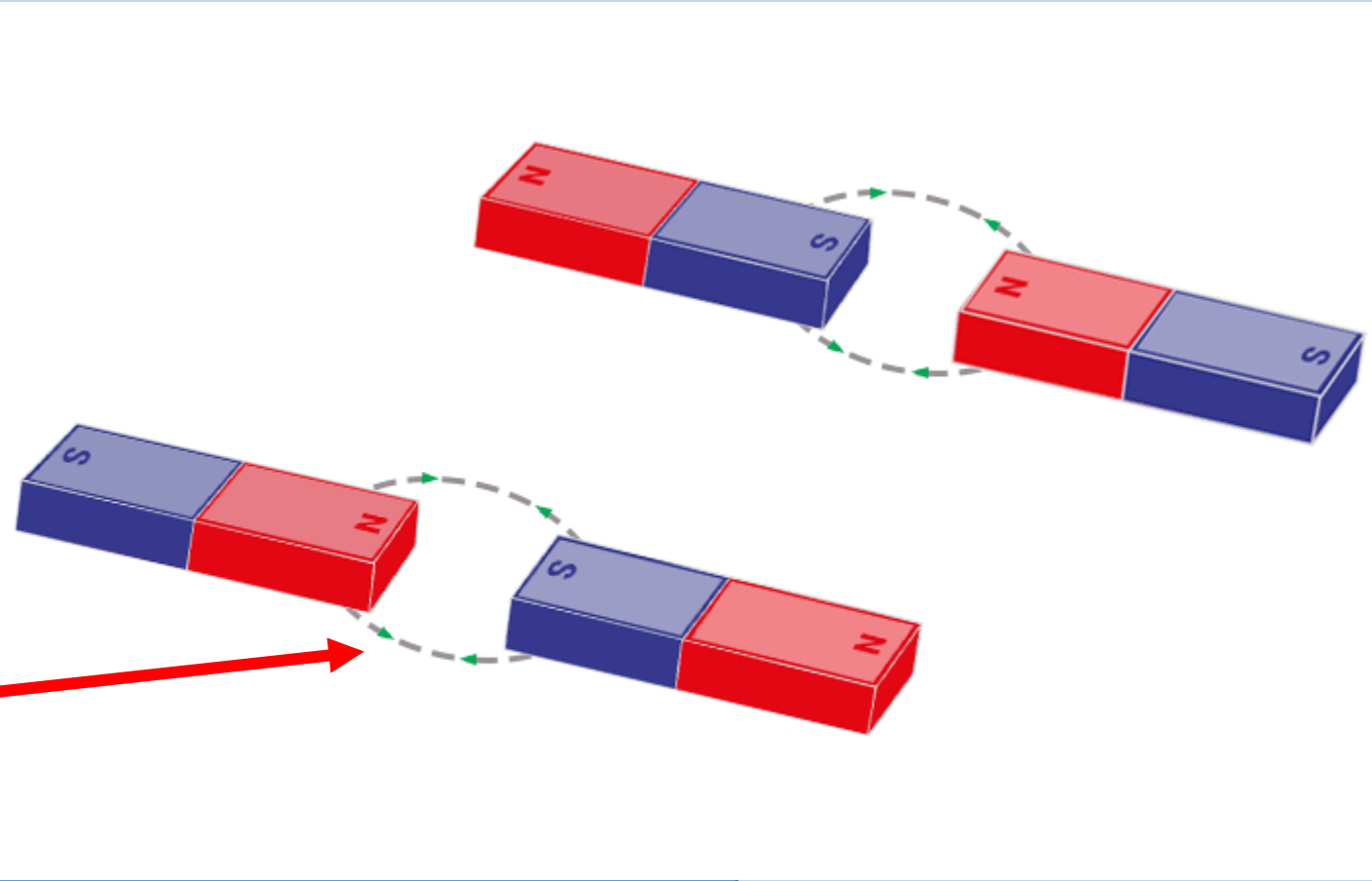

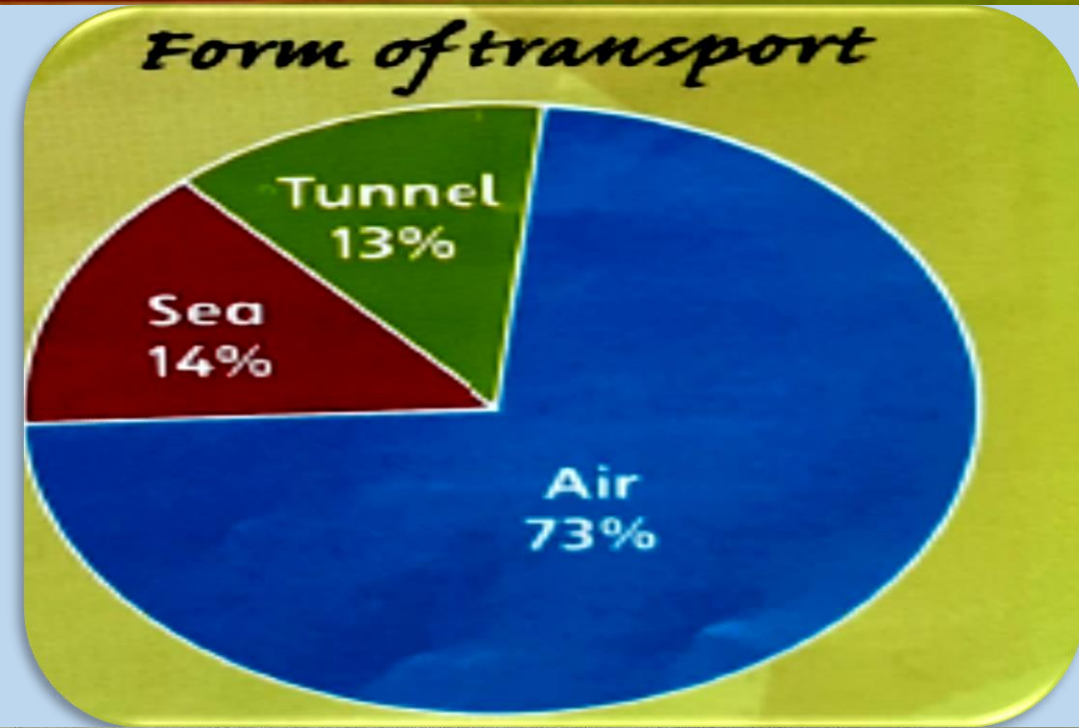

The United Kingdom is one of the most popular countries for tourists. Every year, it attracts about 30 million visitors from around the world. Here are some key facts about the British tourist industry:

Most tourists – about 65% – visit the UK in spring and summer, when the weather is warmer and drier.

Most tourists arrive in the UK by aeroplane. Some tourists also arrive by boat or through the Channel Tunnel from France.

The average tourist stays in the UK for seven or eight days and spends about £640.

The most popular city for tourists is London. About 17 million people visit the capital city every year.

The most popular tourist attractions are the British Museum, the Tate Gallery and the National Gallery. Each place attracts more than 5 million visitors every year.

Many people also visit the UK to see famous monuments. Every year, about 6 million tourists go to a castle, and 5 million visit historic houses.
