

When we talk about finished times, we use:



- a. didn't verb
- b. verb+ed
- c. irregular verbs

go/went

eat/ate

1. He didn't see his mother **last Monday**.

2. He played with his friends **last month**.

3. I drunk a lot of coffee **yesterday**.

drink/drank

Keep in mind:

When you see “did/didn’t”

use **simple** form of the verb.

I didn't **go** yesterday. (go: went)
