Simple Past: We use simple past, when we want talk about something happen in past, and now it is finish.

- I went to park yesterday.
- He played football last Monday.

We have 2 kinds of verb in past:

1- Regular : we just add " d " or " ed " to end of the verb.

Example: Play (Played), Wipe (Wiped)

2- Irregular: Either the structure of the verb changes or its pronunciation.

Example: Go (Went), Read (Read)

Question Form of Simple past

WH QUESTION: use did after WH question.

- What did you do yesterday?
- When did you play football?

" Attention "

When we use did in sentences, WE CAN NOT USE PAST FORM OF VERB!

- When did you played football?
- When did you play football?

YES OR NO QUESTION

Did you play football yesterday?

- Yes, I did. I played football yesterday.
- No, I did not play football OR No, I did not. I play basketball.

NEGATIVE FORM OF PAST SIMPLE

- I ate pizza for dinner last night.
- I did not eat pizza for last night.
