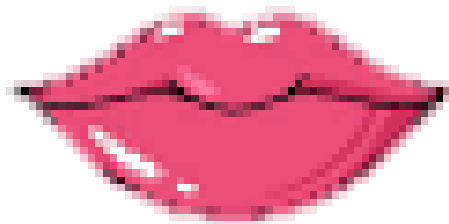
- This painting shows the most famous smile in the world.

 Mona Lisa is an English title that has been derived from the Italian word “Mona” which is a short form of the phrase “ma doona”.




