- 1. Here we have two of the most famous portraits with their unique art style.
- 2. The first one is Mona Lisa, painted by Leonardo da Vinci in 1503. The subject of this painting is a rich merchant's wife, and it took 4 years to paint her. It is now kept in France, and it's worth \$782 million dollars!
- 3. And this one here, is the Girl with Pearl Earring, painted by Vermeer, a Dutch painter, in 1665. No one knows who is the subject of this painting, but some guess she was his daughter. It's kept in Netherlands, and a lot of people also call it The Dutch Mona Lisa.
- 4. In the first look, both paintings are unique and intriguing, but they're different in so many ways. For example, the background in Mona Lisa is very detailed but in the other one it's completely dark.
- 5. Also, the colors in Mona Lisa are more harmonious.
- 6. And about the lighting of the paintings, Girl with a Pearl Earring is light, but Mona Lisa is painted with darker colors.

Guernica vs. Starry night

- 1. On this side we've got two other landscape paintings, both are world-famous and unique.
- 2. This is Guernica, painted by the famous artist Picasso. It's a blue and black and white mural with an anti-war massage. It's kept in Spain.
- 3. The other one is the stunning image of a Starry Night, created by Van Gogh. He told his brother that this is what he saw from his window at the mental hospital. It had 11 stars in it, that some people believe is related to Joseph's dream of 11 stars bowing down to him.
- 4. Both are great painting, but the colors in starry night are so beautiful, but in Guernica the colors are dull.
- 5. Also, the vibe that Guernica gives our is a bit sad and stressful, but starry night gives out a serene and peaceful vibe.
