

Living things: tiger, goat, flower, tree, baby

Non-living things: book, chair, bag, glasses

Seven life processes: Living things: need air to breathe, need food and water, have senses, grow, can move, can produce young, produce waste products.

It's a **short plant** and it **has got flowers**.

It's a **tall plant** and it **hasn't got flowers**.

We **peel** a banana to eat. We **don't peel** a tomato to eat.

Flowers help the plants to make seeds.

Roots support the plants and collect water from the soil.

Stem transports water around the plants.

Leaves make food for the plants.

Plants need water, sunlight, soil and air.
