For example: St. Peter's Basilica

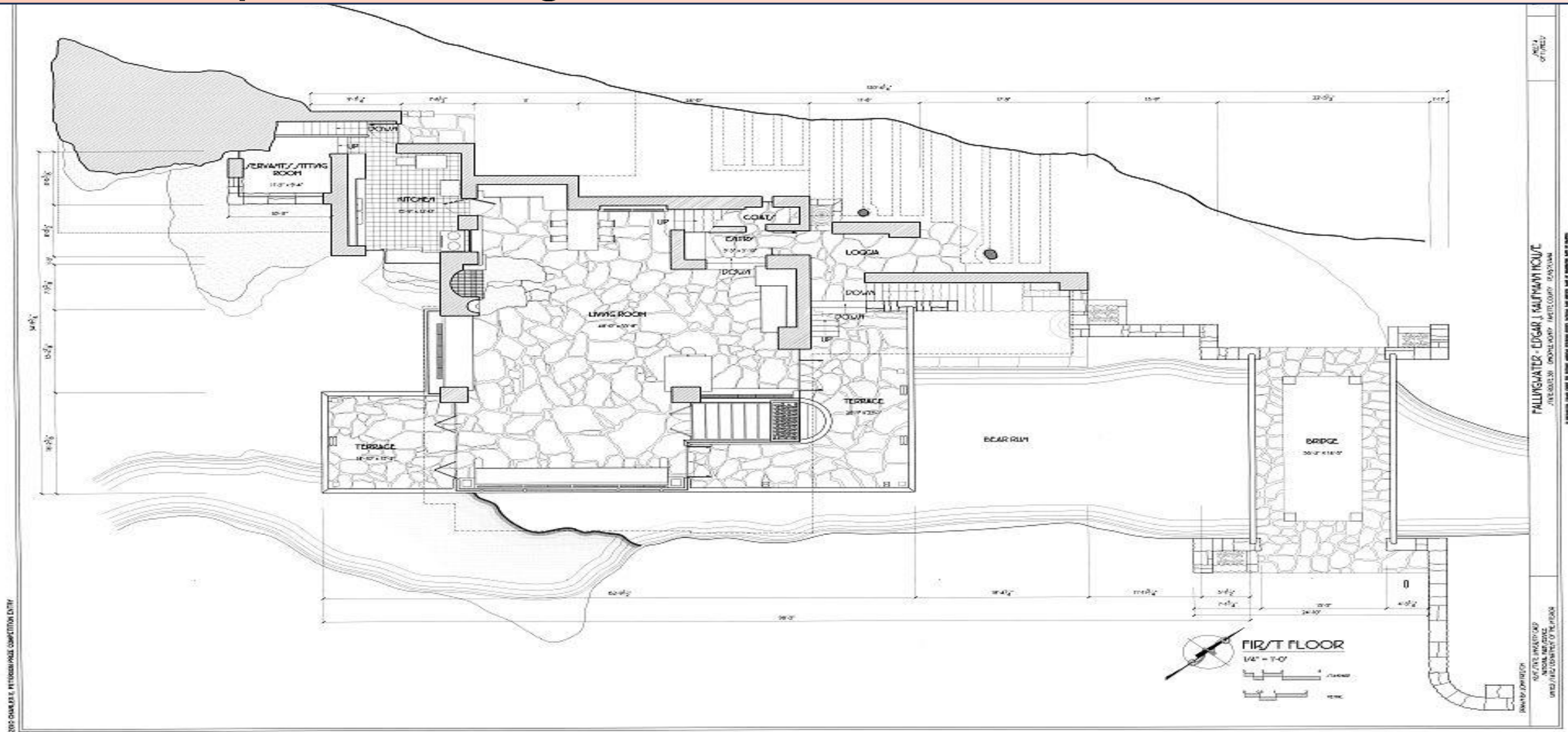


arch: a curved shaped over window & door.

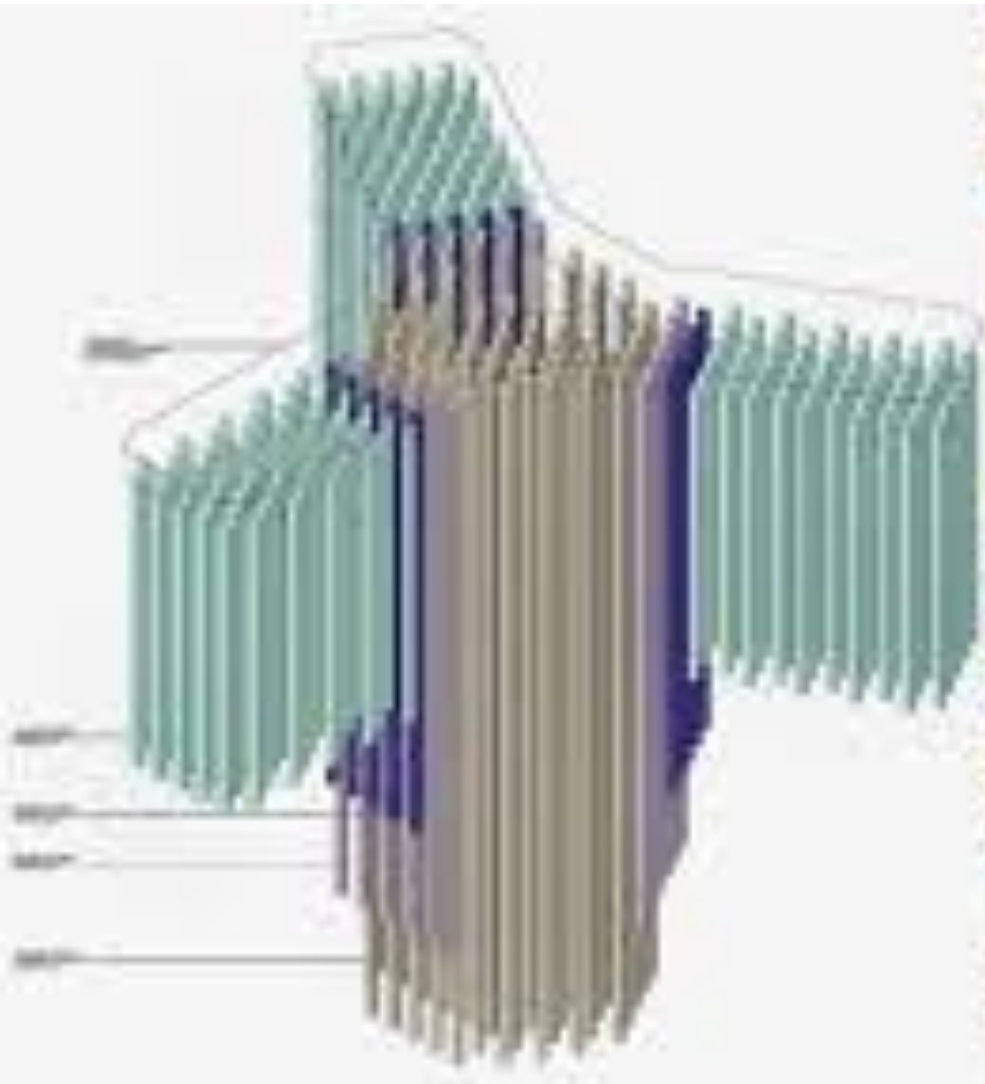
For example: Colosseum in Italy



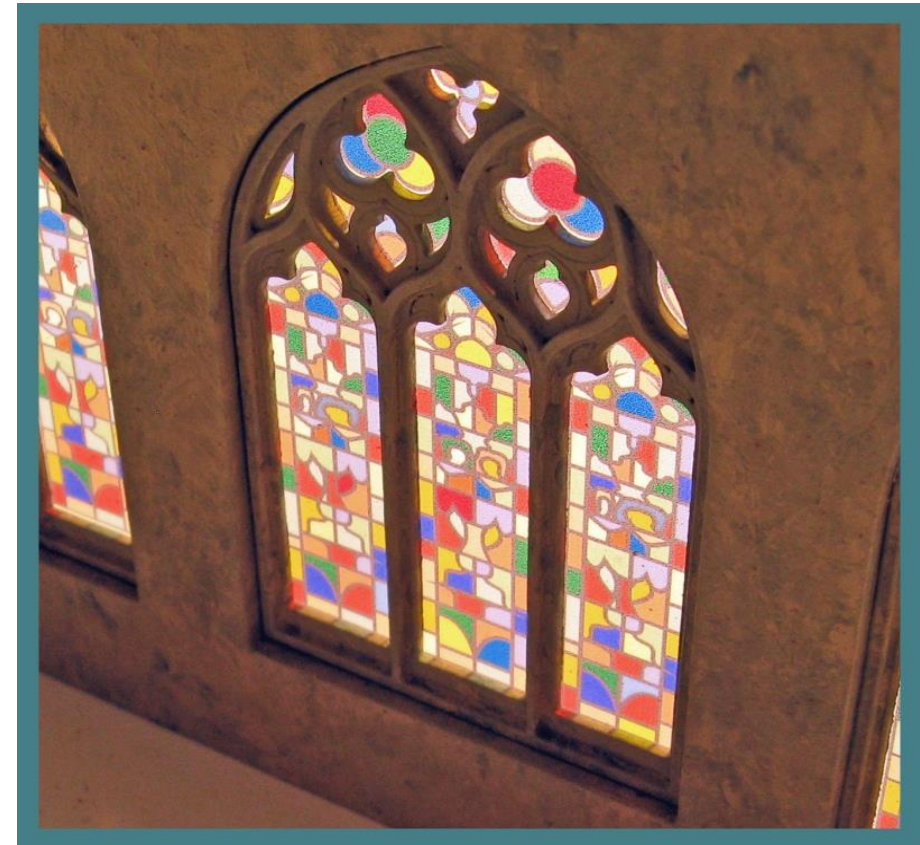
floor plan: a drawing shows building from above.

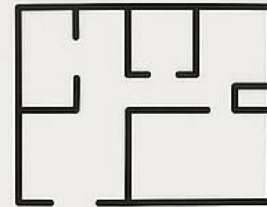

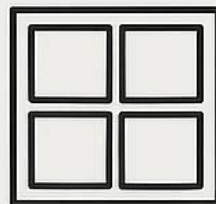
Floor plan

Staircase

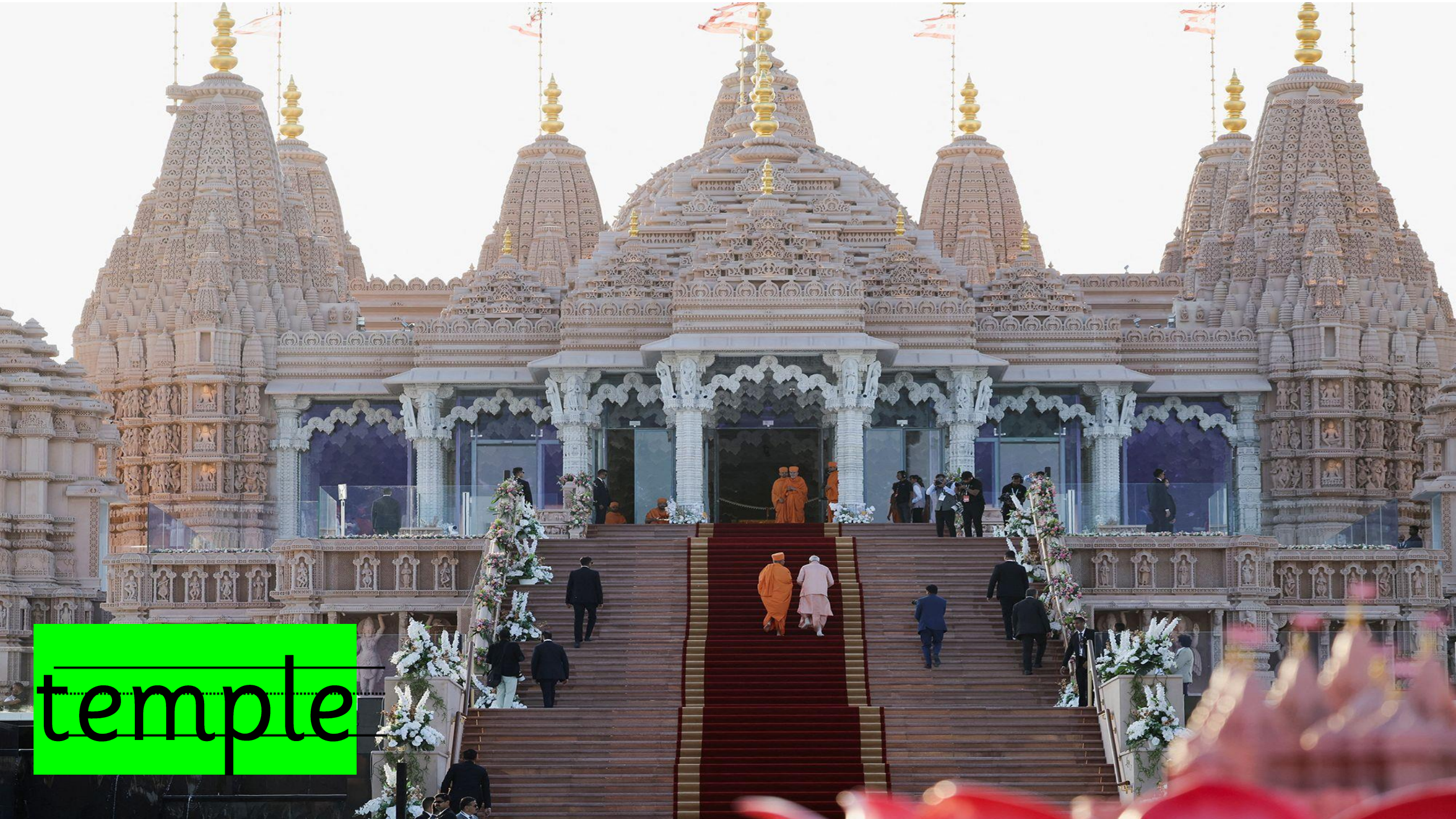
A set of steps that

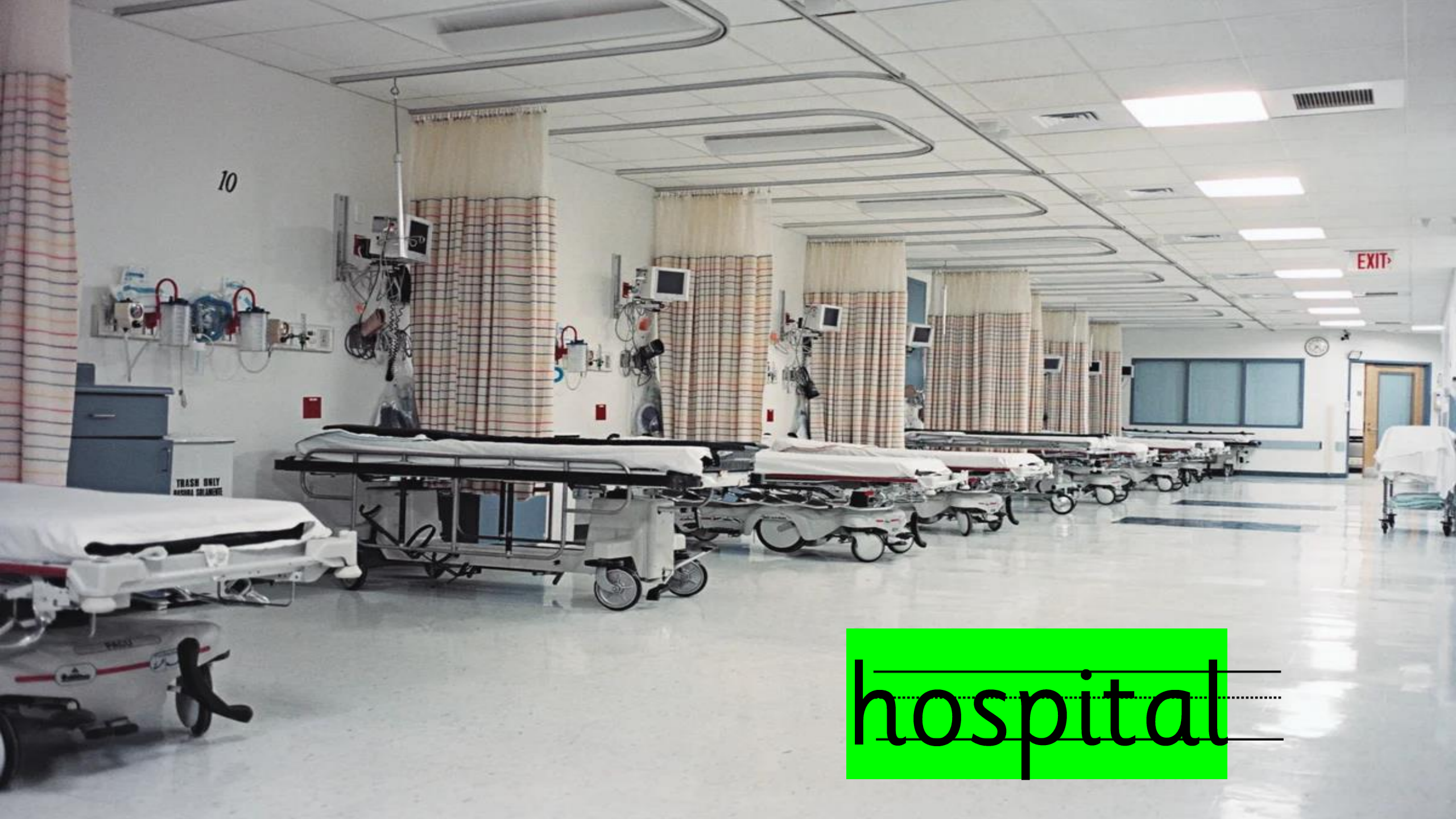
